

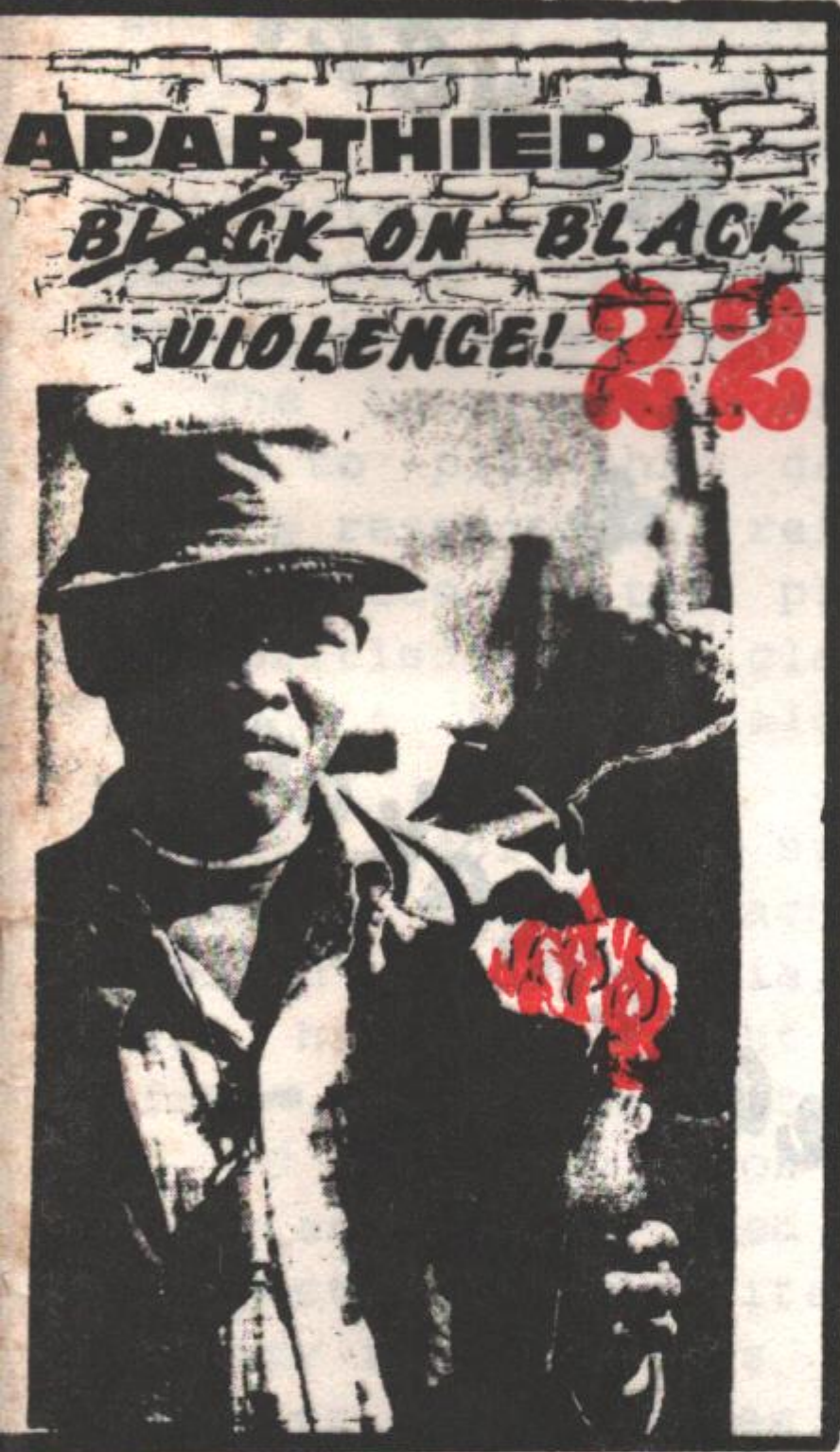

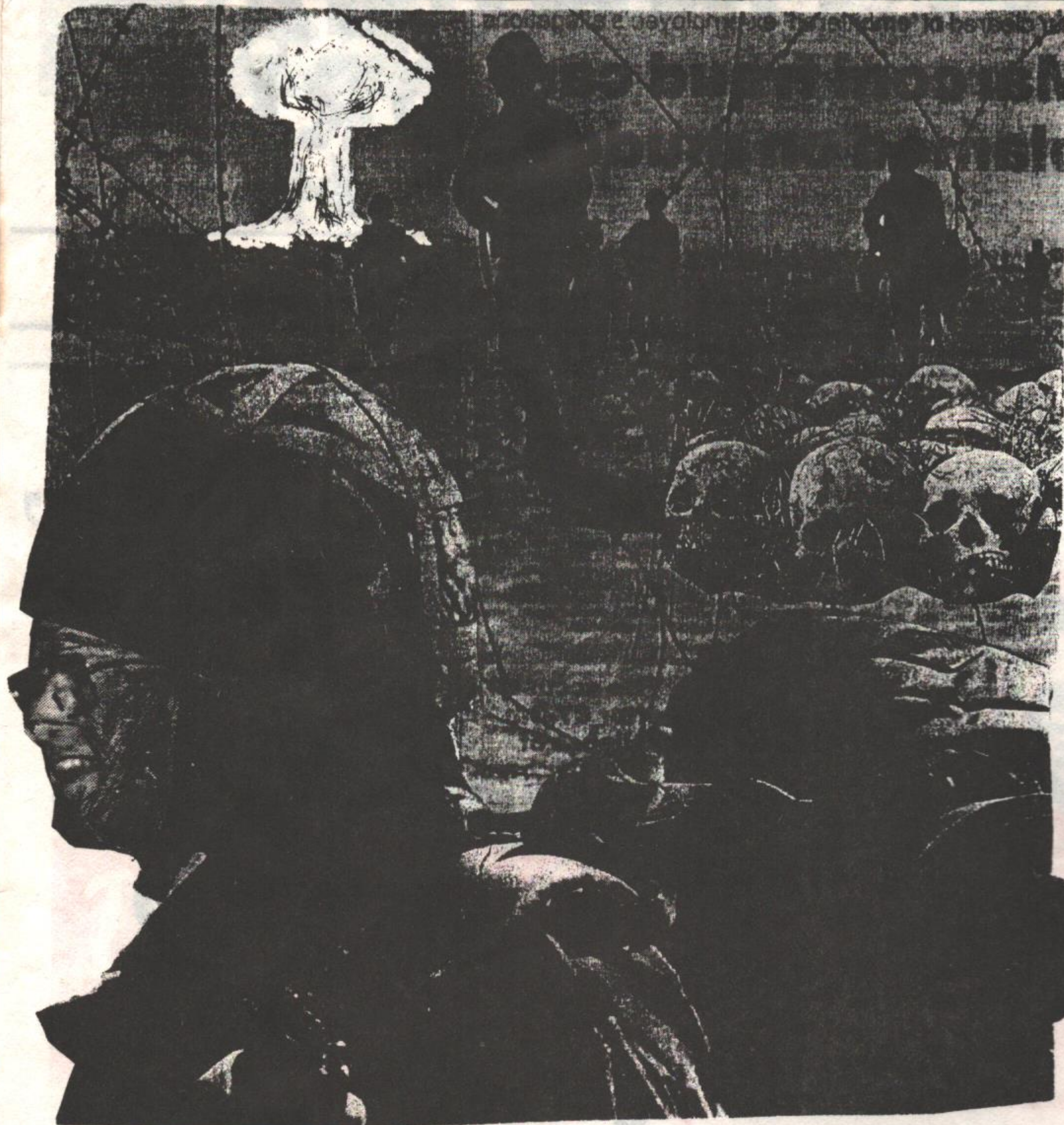

WHY ARE IMPERIALIST FORCES IN THE GULF?

We have to understand that the U.S. rulers will never bother about one country being invaded by another, unless such an invasion is against their interests. It is because the invasion of Kuwait by Iraq has created problems for the U.S., because this invasion does indeed threaten U.S. interests, that the US has taken action.

Imperialist interests are centred around the oil supplies in the region. Since the second world war, the domination of this area by the U.S. has been a key arena for the U.S.'s global power and economic functioning. The cheap flow of oil from the Gulf has become one of the main sources of energy for western imperialist industrial consumption. One third of the world's oil comes from the Gulf region. This cheap oil

reduces production costs and increases the profitability of the West's industry. By strategically maintaining control over this cheap oil from the Gulf, America can maintain its control over the price of oil in the world in general, and this helps the U.S. maintain its dominant position in the world and as head of its bloc.

Oil has been a vital source of cheap energy for the imperialist powers and substantial rises in the price of oil would have a devastating affect on the western imperialist's economies. The west has enjoyed relatively low price oil all through the 80s. In real terms the price of oil was even lower than in 1972 until the invasion of Kuwait.

With the ending of the "cold war" between the two super powers, the economic crisis of imperialism and the emergence of Germany and Japan as stronger economic powers, U.S. imperialism has been in crisis. It is using the Gulf crisis to reassert its role as the worlds number one power, capable of moving its military might thousands of miles around the world to protect its dominance and interests. Interests which the invasion of Kuwait by Iraq has threatened.

This is why even though there is a danger of the whole Middle East being thrown into turmoil, the massacre of thousands upon thousands of people and the risk of the oil fields burning in the event of war, U.S. imperialism is prepared to risk all that. It is prepared to fight a devastating war NOT to defend freedom or the territory of any nation, but rather to ensure its dominance of the region, and its position as the number one imperialist power.

SADDAM HUSSEIN IS A REACTIONARY IN AN IMPERIALIST WORLD!

"But aren't they all as bad as each other? He's an imperialist too isn't he?"

Some people think that because Saddam Hussein invaded Kuwait that makes him an imperialist and therefore he should be treated like one. Some people believe we should ask both Iraq and the U.S. to get out of Kuwait and oppose both of them equally. Saddam Hussein does have his own ambitions to become a big power in the region, but at the same time, he is not an imperialist force. He is a reactionary created by imperialism to serve their interests. The region is already under the control and domination of the imperialist forces. Iraq is not an international power operating on a world scale or having big corporations and banks which exploit and oppress people around the world. It does not act in the same way as imperialist forces like the U.S. or Soviet Union, able to go round the world to countries thousands of miles from its home bullying, oppressing and exploiting other nations. In short, it is not an imperialist country.

The conflict between Iraq and the big powers is actually a fight between a small dog and a pack of big dogs headed by U.S. imperialism. People should oppose the big powers going around the world bullying other nations and peoples across the globe. Saddam Hussein was supported by the U.S. right up to a few days before the invasion. We should not take the same, or "even handed", approach to the two sides in this conflict.

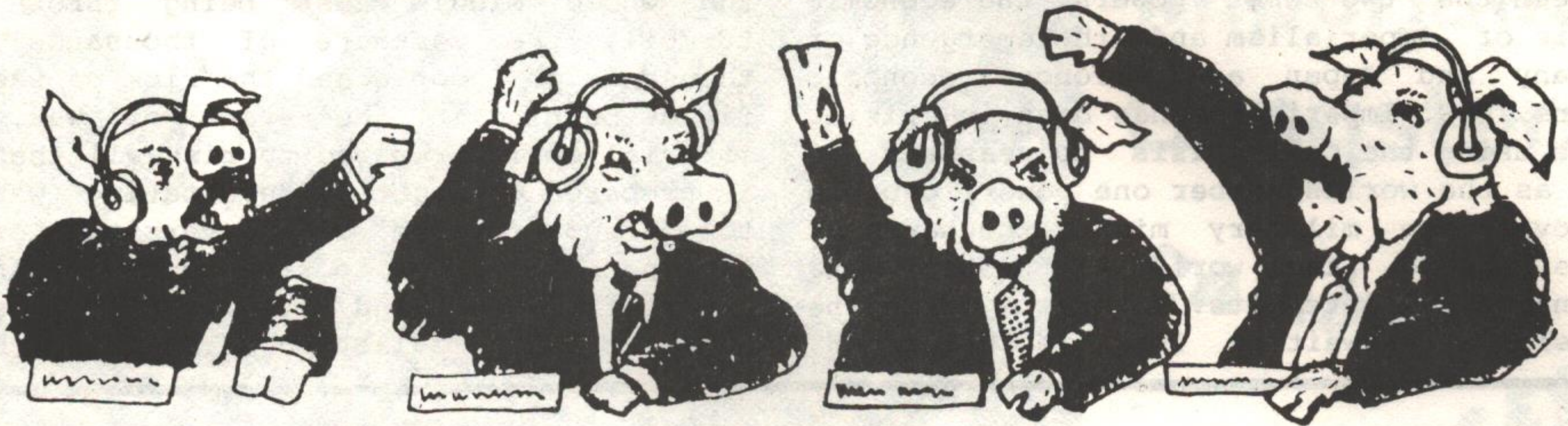
What should our stand be then?

We have to stand with the masses of people against imperialism and Saddam Hussein but our first demand has got to be for the U.S. to get out of the Gulf and the whole Middle East. This is the only stand that we can take, supporting revolutionary developments in the countries of the region, and the right of the oppressed Arab people for self determination. One of the basic principles of self determination is that the imperialist forces must never be allowed to go around the world dictating and bullying other nations. Not even if these nations or

small countries are ruled by reactionaries like Saddam Hussein. The people of the region should deal with Saddam Hussein, with the revolutionary, violent seizure of power through a people's war under the leadership of the proletariat.

Our stand has got to be revolutionary defeatism. Nothing else will do. We want, and welcome, many many defeats for british imperialism at the hands of its enemy, even if this enemy is Saddam Hussein who is himself an oppressor of the Iraqi and Kurdish people.



UNITED NATIONS? INTERNATIONAL PIG STY!**WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE U.N.?**

"Look, there's been an invasion, surely someone has to do something about it, I mean, isn't the U.S. defending freedom and democracy by standing against the invasion of Kuwait? And this U.N., it stands for justice for people, yeah?"

Well actually, no and no.

The United Nations is a pig sty where all the reactionary heads of government sit. Its become famous for being very choosy about where and when it intervenes, and is known for doing nothing about the aggression and atrocities of the big powers, about the crimes that they are committing.

UN -- SEEING, HEARING, AND SPEAKING NO EVIL

The Iraqi invasion of Iran was backed by all the imperialist powers because it served their interests in the region. There was no U.N. resolution then. And when Israel occupied the West Bank and attacked Lebanon in 1982, keeping the south of Lebanon under occupation, the U.N. likewise took no action. Nor about the apartheid system when there were calls for sanctions and an embargo of South Africa. The U.N. did nothing about the years of destruction and murder of the Vietnamese people by the US. Nor the U.S. invasions of Grenada or Panama and the installing of U.S. backed governments in these countries. When Syria recently attacked and occupied Lebanon killing hundreds, the UN ignored it, as a reward for Syria's alliance with U.S. imperialism over their maneuvering in the Gulf. The recent massacre of over 21 Palestinians by Israel showed the people of the world how the UN operates, when as one official said: "They had to work hard to find a language of condemnation which would be acceptable to the U.S." -- a language so hypercritically "condemning" that it is just empty words.

UN PIGSTY SCAMPERS TO SAFEGUARD U.S. INTERESTS IN THE GULF.

Yet since the invasion of Kuwait, the U.N. has so far passed no less than thirteen resolutions against Iraq, endorsed the food embargo and the use of force. Why? Because

the invasion was against the interests of the imperialists. All of the imperialist forces, particularly the U.S., Soviet Union and Britain have a common interest in the region -- to have imperialist control of the oil resources of the Gulf. This common interest binds them and is one reason why the U.N. has been so quick in passing resolution after resolution against Iraq.

The U.S. and Britain had already been using force against ships destined for Iraq and had even started shooting at them two weeks before the U.N. resolution approving the use of military force to enforce the food blockade. The U.S.-led pack of gangster mafiosos use the UN resolutions to starve millions of Iraqi people and to justify its murderous activities in the region. A recent quote from an U.S. administrative official printed in the New York Times says it all "If at some point action has to be taken, it obviously would be politically useful to have UN sanctions." This shows the U.S. is actually using this UN resolution as a cover for its atrocities and that they are hoping to create some public opinion around the lie of how "peaceful" they are, looking for a peaceful solution, diplomatic, negotiate settlement and not rushing for war. Recently, Baker, U.S. secretary of state visited various countries drumming up support for the resolution justifying the use of force against Iraq. The efforts of the Western imperialists have resulted in a new resolution, giving a deadline for Iraq withdrawal from Kuwait of 15th January 1991. This gives the U.S. the edge to start attacking Iraq anytime thereafter.

Maintaining the UN and creating illusions about it -- gives legitimacy to the whole imperialist world and these do eat dog gangster moves. The fact is that if we are really serious about stopping the U.S., Britain, the Soviet Union....from starting war in the Gulf we must expose and oppose the UN for what it is -- a pig sty where imperialists and reactionaries reign and not promote this justification for the U.S. to attack.

There are some people who believe that the UN solution is what is needed to stop the war. But what is the UN solution?

Even if Saddam is helped to a defeat by all the crisis forced on the country by the food embargo and sanctions, it will only have been by starving millions of people in Iraq that the so called "peaceful" UN solution will have been reached. And there is nothing peaceful about that. The people of the world know the UN is controlled by imperialist and reactionary forces.

If he is toppled it will be the big imperialist powers that will benefit, not the people of the region. After all it would be the terms of the imperialists, for the control of the region, which had brought an end to the crisis and they would either put another more trusted reactionary in power, or deploy other imperialist plans.

The truth is that no UN resolution can justify the starvation and massacre of the Iraqi people by a pack of imperialist gangsters.

NEGOTIATIONS AND WAR DRIVE



In October Bush used the hostage issue in the U.S. embassy in Kuwait to announce his aim for an offensive preparation against Iraq. In Britain, the close ally of the U.S. Mrs Thatcher, the ex-prime minister, at a Tory conference said: you do not negotiate, "you get him out, make him pay and see that he is never in a position to do these things again. It would be very short-sighted to agree to a settlement...."

Any signs or suggestion of negotiations from Iraq were being ignored by the U.S.; and even the suggestion by Edward Heath and Willy Brant the former Chancellor of Germany, envoys of the West, for Iraq's readiness for negotiations were ignored.

Different war scenarios have been played out on BBC tv on how to wage war with Iraq, with all the stages and possibilities being analysed by ex-commanders and specialists.

Hospitals have been on alert for the casualties of the war for weeks.

The leaders of the church and religious establishments were drawn into the preparations of the war machine, putting out the propaganda that the Gulf war would be a "just war".

PIG STY OINKS THE OKAY

As we were getting nearer to the end of November the case for the use of force against Saddam Hussein seemed to become even more inevitable than ever, Baker started a tour of the five permanent members of the security council to secure a UN resolution to use force against Iraq. The oink oink from the pig sty gives the okay to the U.S.'s request, and the final date of 15th January 1991 is set for Saddam Hussein to get out of Kuwait.

SURPRISE, SURPRISE!

But to the astonishment of many the next day Bush announces that James Baker is to go to Iraq to meet Saddam Hussein for negotiations later in December and that Tariq Aziz the Iraqi Foreign Minister is to visit Bush in January. This move might seem to some people to be a sign of the U.S.'s willingness to find a peaceful solution, but the fact is that Bush is trying to mobilize public opinion in the U.S. and amongst U.S. allies behind the intended massacre in the Gulf. The cost of the war in human lives, a Pentagon analysis suggests, will be thousands just amongst the U.S. troops, and this is effecting public opinion. A wave of opposition and resistance against the U.S. intervention and war in the Gulf has already started among a wide range of people in the U.S. and other countries.

There are contradictory talks from the U.S. and the allied forces about the possibility of a "peaceful" settlement in the Gulf. A senior White House official said on NCB news network that "there will be a treaty which is acceptable to everybody".

But Bush and his administration have publicly and categorically refused and denied any suggestion of secret talks, face saving or dealings with Iraq saying that nothing less than a complete withdrawal of Iraq from Kuwait will do. They have firmly, publicly and politically dug themselves in for the complete withdrawal of Iraq from Kuwait. This would be a humiliating and dangerous capitulation for Saddam Hussein and it would be equally difficult for the U.S. to accept any deal which could be seen as capitulation to Saddam.

What if negotiations work? Isn't everything alright then?

Negotiation with Saddam Hussein might even end up in some kind of face saving or other deal and a partial or complete withdrawal of Iraqi forces from Kuwait. It might even be done by the UN using a multilateral "peace-keeping" force remaining there for some time. U.S. and Saudi officials have been reported to say that even after the war or peaceful withdrawal from Kuwait, there would be a plan for a U.S. force to remain in the region, and to possibly have a U.S. base in Kuwait.

But any negotiation goes against the real interests of the people in the region and their right to self determination, and leaves the heads of the imperialist and the reactionary governments there to decide what should be done. In fact negotiation, like war, is a continuation of the policy of the reactionary and the big imperialist powers to control the region and oppress the people. As with the UN settlement after the Iran-Iraq war which left both the reactionary heads of state in Iran and Iraq in power and the people still being

oppressed, there can be no high expectations from this latest quest by the UN and the imperialists. Neither the U.S. nor the UN have the legitimate right to go into the Gulf and start a negotiation to decide the future of this region.

The effects of war are being examined by the masses. People from all sections of society, on a mass scale, are opposing war in the Gulf. The Bush administration badly needs public opinion behind it, therefore it claimed that it is "going the extra mile" for peace and announced the start of talks with Iraq. But what Bush actually said was: "I am not hopeful that we're going to get a lot out of this, we're just going the extra mile." and later James Baker, U.S. Secretary of State, reported to the U.S. Congress that if Saddam Hussein does not comply with the UN resolution totally, "that force must and will be used, and the attack will be suddenly, massively and decisively."

The Bush administration had to calm its big power allies -- who thought that maybe the U.S. had a deal with Saddam up its sleeves -- when worried allies like the French announced their own plans for negotiations with Saddam.

The latest UN resolution against Iraq giving permission for the use of force is a blank cheque for the U.S. who do not need to return to the security council for further endorsement.

Opposition from below against U.S. aggression in the Middle East must be organized to stop the war before it starts, no matter what it takes, and as for Saddam Hussein the people in the region need to get rid of him by a revolutionary people's war.

THE SINISTER PLANS OF THE SOVIET UNION FOR THE REGION.

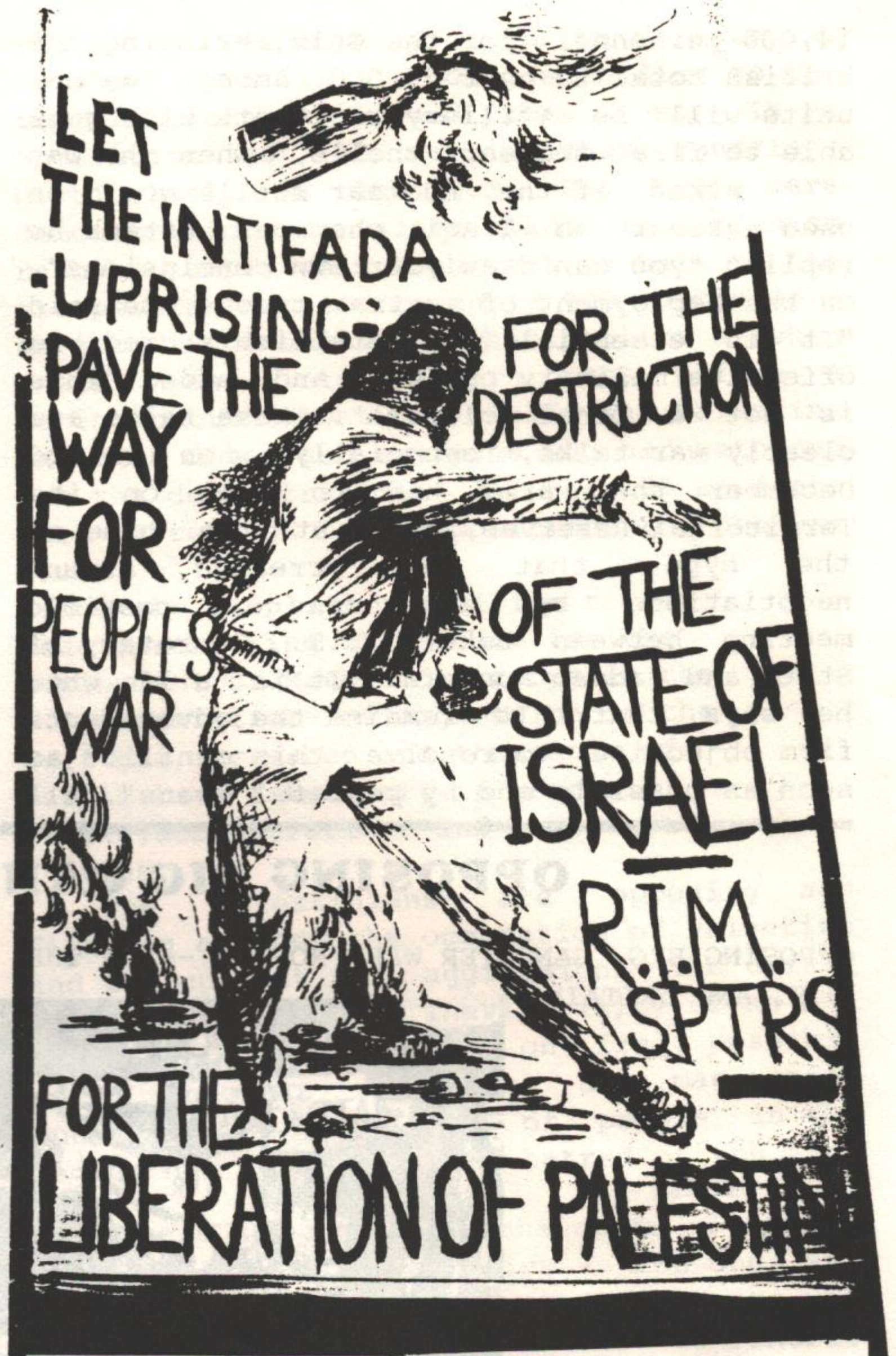
The Soviet Union has its own imperialist plans for the region. It has colluded with the U.S. in the recent crisis, because it is in deep political and economic crisis, with one oppressed nationality after another rising up, and in need of dollars, "aid" and deals from Western imperialism. Also because of its internal crisis the Soviet Union was unable to rally its forces behind it. From the beginning it endorsed the U.S. led aggression in the Gulf and the UN resolutions against Iraq. If its forces had come under the leadership of the U.S., it would have been a total capitulation to U.S. imperialism. The Soviet union has avoided this by calling for more dialogue in a search for a peaceful settlement with Iraq, hoping by this to grasp some initiative from the crisis in the region and try to regain its reputation of being the natural ally of the Arab nation, thus deepening its claws in the region. The prospect of the U.S. being dragged into a long term war in the Gulf could be favourable to the Soviet Unions imperialist plans in the future.

ISRAEL THE MILITARY OUTPOST OF THE U.S. IN THE MIDDLE EAST.

After the latest UN security council resolution legalising the use of force against Iraq, it seemed that the long put off Middle East conference, dealing with the occupation of the West Bank and Gaza Strip and the Palestinian "issue", was about to be agreed on by the U.S. But as the draft resolution was being drawn up, once again, surprise, surprise, the security council could not find a language that was acceptable to the U.S. imperialists. This time, because of the Gulf crisis it is not able to veto the motion and be seen publicly supporting Israel, so it is using the excuse that there should be no use of words which might imply a relation between the two problems of the Gulf and Palestine, because then it might seem as though Saddam Hussein has been able to link the two issues together.

Shamir, Israel's Prime Minister currently in the U.S. has been talking about the possibility of Israel making war on Iraq later, or taking some other measures to destroy Iraqi military power if there is going to be a peaceful settlement rather than a war. Israel has always been in favour of an all out attack on Iraq throughout the whole Gulf crisis, and, together with U.S. and Britain, has been insisting that the Gulf issue and other issues -- meaning the Palestinian issue in the Middle East -- are not linked. But the fact is that they are linked by U.S. dominance of the region and the control and oppression of the masses of people.

The creation of the Zionist state of Israel by the U.S. and Britain and their full support for all its aggressive and murderous actions are to promote and safeguard their imperialist interests, especially those of the U.S.



For the oppressed masses of the world, particularly the Arab masses and the Palestinians the two issues are linked and can only be thrown off by the revolutionary seizure of power, the destruction of reactionary systems, the ending of imperialist domination and the building of a system based on the genuine interest of the people.

DON'T BELIEVE THE HYPE ABOUT SADDAM'S NUCLEAR WEAPONS!

In order to mobilise public opinion in the U.S. behind their war machine, the U.S. media polls started asking people if they approved of war with Iraq if Iraq has nuclear weapons. To complete this recent propaganda, in a speech to American troops in Saudi Arabia, in November, Bush said "Every day that passes brings Saddam Hussein one day closer to realising his goal of a nuclear weapons arsenal. And that is one reason, frankly, why more and more our mission is marked by a real sense of urgency". His message is that we have to go to war. There has already been talk of destroying Saddam Hussein's

army in imperialist circles, even if Hussein decides to leave Kuwait.

The hype around the nuclear weapons of the Iraqi army is another sinister development in their deadly game of finding some justifications to start war with Iraq with public opinion behind them. The fact is that the imperialist guns and missiles that could carry nuclear warheads, and the warheads themselves, are already there. Already over 500 nuclear warheads and chemical weapons are there.

In another drive to prepare for war, on the 22nd November, Tom King announced the deployment of an additional

14,000 personnel for the Gulf, bringing the British total to over 30,000. Among the new units will be artillery regiments with guns able to fire nuclear shells, when he was asked if the nuclear shells would be used against an Iraqi chemical attack he replied "you can draw your own conclusions". On the deployment of extra troops he said "It is essential to establish a credible offensive military option", and added "This is not a final closure". These talks are clearly war talks, especially when on 3rd December the army had to call on its Territorial Reserves, just at the time of the hype that Bush created around negotiations by announcing a possible meeting between Baker, U.S. Secretary of State and Saddam Hussein. It is a lie when he says that "It remains the governments firm objective to resolve this conflict as soon as possible and by peaceful means". All

the evidence shows that the U.S. and its closest ally, Britain, with the rest of the gangster's pack, are preparing for an all out attack on Iraq. There has already been talks in U.S. and other imperialist countries about carving Iraq into small parts and give it to its neighbouring countries, and these hypocrites still dare to say it is all about Kuwait's self-determination and not their imperialist interest.

In a parallel move, a further 200,000 U.S. troops are going to the Gulf, doubling the total number of U.S. troops there to around 450,000. Among the sophisticated weapons and tanks that the U.S. is sending, battleship Missouri, with huge 16 inch guns and cruise missiles, and capable of carrying nuclear warheads is one of them.

All these moves are war moves, to massacre thousands upon thousands of people and probably millions if nuclear weapons are used by the imperialists.

OPPOSING BIG GANGSTER WAR MOVES!

OPPOSING BIG GANGSTER WAR MOVES! -- IN THE U.S. AND BRITAIN!



New York, October 20.

Despite all the propaganda and hypocrisy the U.S. used to try to justify why U.S. troops had to go to the Gulf, the Bush administration could not forge a "public consensus".

Opposition to the build up of the war machine and U.S. intervention has already started, and is growing before the first shot has even been fired, unlike the anti-Vietnam war resistance which didn't start until after the war began. Tens of thousands of people from different sections of American society, including: Vietnam Veterans against the war, students from different universities, proletariat from the housing projects, activists, Palestinians,

RCYB (Revolutionary Communist Youth Brigade) are mobilising against the war. There have been many demonstrations in U.S., including outside Army recruiting stations, American flags have been burnt, slogans like "Hell no, we won't go!", "Fuck the U.S. and all its might! Revolutionary war is the one we'll fight!", "Amandla-- Power to the people", "Long Live Palestine" and "We won't fight for oil!" were chanted.

Here in Britain, people have taken to the streets in mass demonstrations in different cities up and down the country. Veterans from the Falklands and Korean wars have taken part, as well as, activists, students, proletarian youth, Palestinians

and Arabs and other oppressed nationalities. More than 20,000 people took part in a national demonstration in London on 24th November. The slogans put out included: "british and U.S. gangsters out of the Gulf!", "Fuck US and Britain and all their might!", "Revolutionary war is the one we'll fight!" and "For the destruction of the state of Israel, Long live Palestine!" were chanted. Some youth and Palestinians joined with supporters of R.I.M. at the rally. As the British, U.S. and Israeli flags were torched, people encircled the burning flag and joined in the slogans. A Korean war veteran approached one of our comrades and said "What you are doing is good. Keep on doing it. I have fought for these rich bastards in World War 2 and Korea and did not know. But I know it now, that it is all for the interest of these rich bastards."

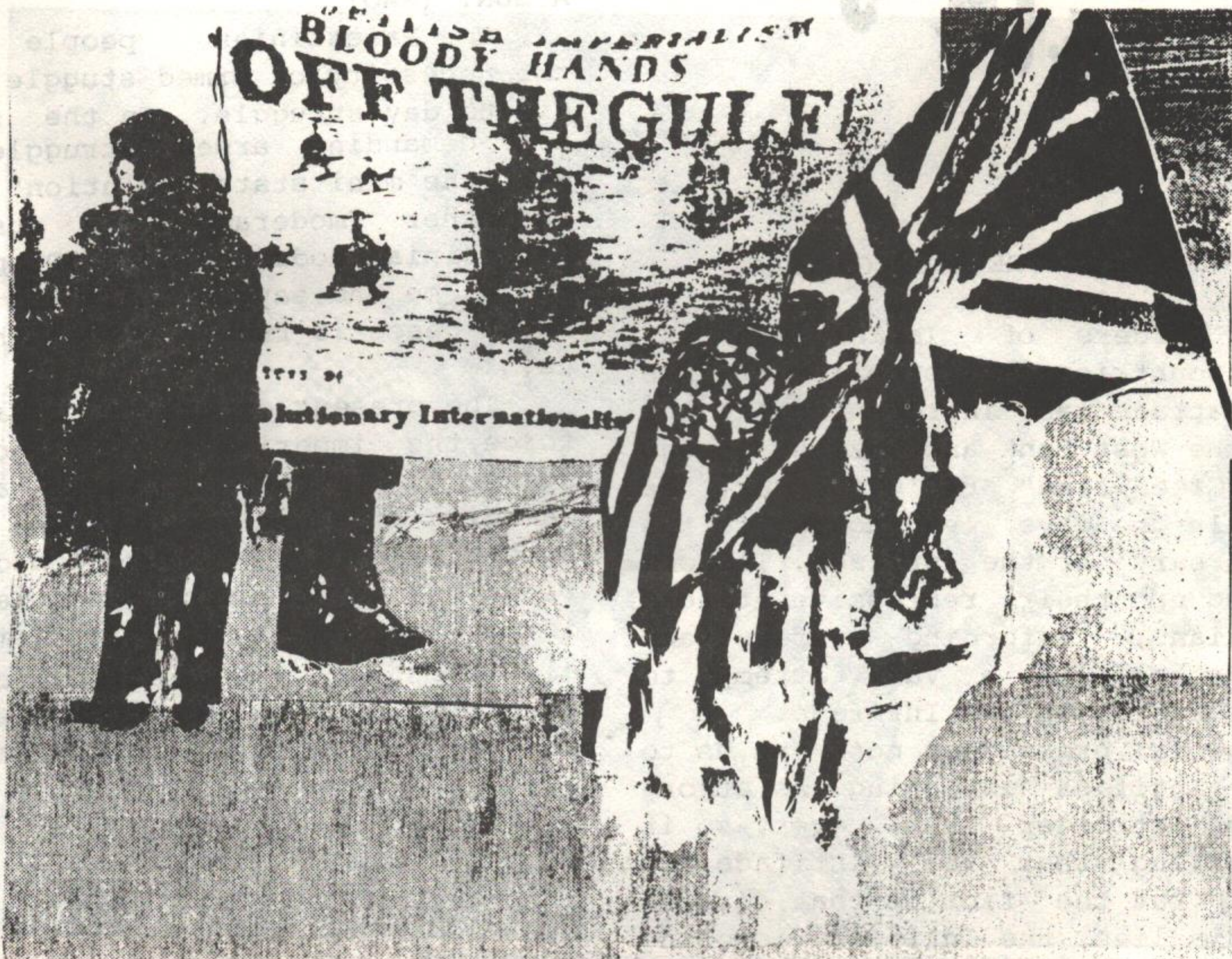
OPPOSING BIG GANGSTER WAR MOVES! -- IN THE MIDDLE EAST!

In the Arabic countries hardly a day goes by without a demonstration against the imperialist presence in the Gulf. Often the flags of Israel, Britain and the U.S.-- most hated for the creation and support of the Israeli state -- are burnt and throughout the region tens of thousands have enrolled to fight against the U.S. imperialist led aggression in the region. But the bourgeois media has been keeping quiet about all this.

The media, especially in Britain is trying to show that all is going according to the imperialist's will and that there is no opposition to the war in other countries, particularly in the U.S. But there were demonstrations by Palestinians, in Jordanian refugee camps, when Bush went to talk to the troops. In Morocco recently 700 people were arrested in Casablanca when police smashed their way into their homes before a demonstration about the Gulf and Palestine and then dispersed everyone who had gathered for the demonstration. In Fez 90 students were arrested for opposition to the war moves.

Since the people's opposition to the reactionary King of Morocco for the deployment of Morocco's troops in the U.S. imperialist led aggression in the Gulf has increased and thousands of people have taken part in general strike, demonstrations and other activities.

The Palestinians are opposing and fighting against the occupation of Palestine and the current U.S. aggression. The crisis of the Gulf and the inevitability of an all out imperialist attack on Iraq, possibly using nuclear warheads, and massacring hundreds upon thousands of people in the region has increased the hatred of the Arab People know that these two issues -- the state of Israel and the U.S. Gulf war drive -- are one, and are about nothing but the interests of imperialist gangsters to be able to control the people and wealth of the region.



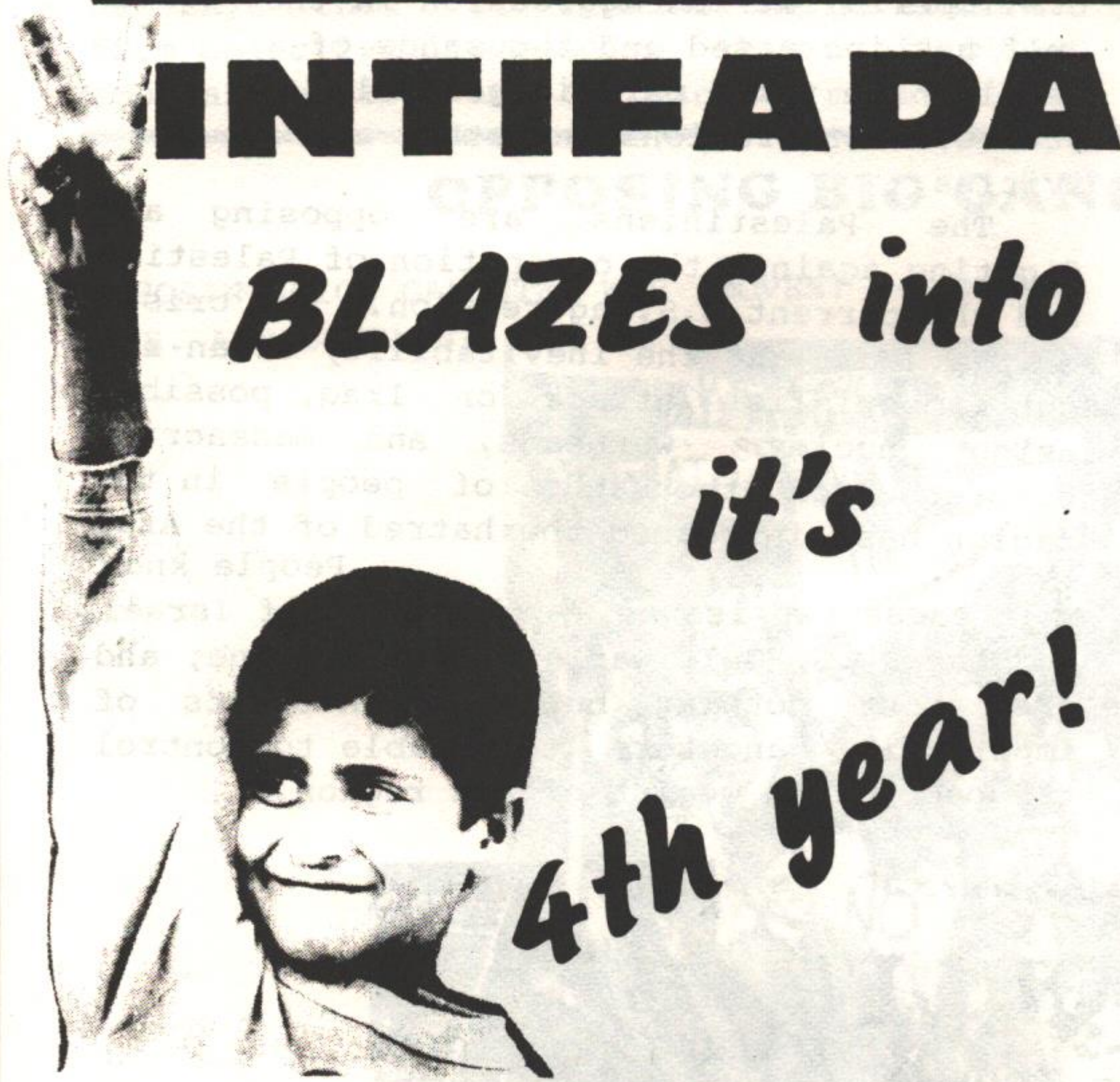
THE IMPERIALISTS CAN PLAN, BUT IT IS THE MASSES WHO MAKE HISTORY!

If this reactionary war starts in the Gulf there is a very real possibility of the whole region being thrown into turmoil by revolutionary war. The deep and long term hatred of U.S. and British imperialism in the Middle East for carving up and robbing this area, for butchering people and supporting the reactionary regimes there, and the hatred of Israel could ignite armed struggle and revolutionary movements in the region, especially among the Palestinians.

The U.S. wants this war to control this key strategic region, to keep and increase its grip on oil supplies and to give a warning to the rebellious peoples of the area. But a war in the Gulf is likely to

give just the opposite message to the masses there -- already, the current U.S. aggression is focussing all the anger, and creating openings for the masses to go against the reactionary rulers all over the region.

As for us here in Britain, we have to oppose all war moves. We must welcome all defeats inflicted upon British imperialism by its enemies, and must work to ensure that these defeats are exploited to the utmost. Redoubling our efforts to build and develop the revolutionary movement here, under the banner of Marxism-Leninism-Maoism, to dig the grave of British imperialism, so that it becomes history, and to play our part in bringing about a new world order and the end of all exploitation and oppression.

INTIFADA NIGHT AND DAY, REVOLUTION ALL THE WAY.

On the borders of Israel and its neighbouring countries the Israeli army has come under attack as in recent weeks the Intifada in the West Bank and Gaza strip and inside the "Green Line" pre '67 border, has intensified. In the days leading up to the fourth anniversary of the Intifada, Israeli troops stepped up their repressive attacks on Palestinians, enforcing curfews and closing down schools in a vain attempt to stop the celebration of the Intifada.

The bourgeois press does not want us to know that the Intifada is going as strong as, and even stronger than, ever, so it keeps propagating that the Intifada is "dying down". But the fact is that despite all these media lies, the Intifada is going strong, spreading inside the "green line"

and blazing into its fourth year. The press does not want us to see that the Intifada is a form of struggle, of fighting, and a way of life in occupied territory, so it tries to portray the Intifada as kids who throw stones at Israeli soldiers just because they have no school and nothing else to do. But try as it may, the media cannot hide the oppression and the resistance, it cannot hide the truth that the Intifada is a nation of Palestinian women, men, children and infants, young and old, healthy and infirm, risen up against the downpressor and determined to be rid of the occupying forces and to liberate themselves, with stones, with knives, and yes, with guns.

"POLITICAL POWER COMES OUT OF THE BARREL OF A GUN!" (MAO)

The Palestinian people have realised the necessity of armed struggle through their day to day struggle. On the streets people are demanding armed struggle. They do not want the mini state "solution" that the PLO and other "moderates" are pushing for. One Palestinian moderate says "People are coming up to me and saying: "Look all this business about peace is rubbish. Look what they do to us."

The present explosive situation may even force the imperialists to go for a mini state or other dealings as the least damaging alternative. But the word on the street is loud, strong and defiant -- the right of the Palestinian people to Palestine is not negotiable. What the masses want is all the way liberation through armed struggle. And they know that without the destruction of the Zionist state of Israel and smashing of the domination of imperialism there can be no true liberation.



In the words of a Syrian song, popular throughout the Arab world:
Fascist soldiers, you will come to nothing!
Your clubs and murderous rifle fire-
Fascists, maintain your seige
We will continue to defy you.
We have declared one anger, one revolution.
In Jerusalem, Gaza and the West Bank.
We the valient stonethrowers
Will not be terrorized by
Broken bones, detention camps or tents.
Our land beckons and we must respond

In the refugee camps the Israelis block the alleyways with cement filled barrels to stop the youths from defying them. But the barrels are knocked down within a real short time. liberation. This is the spirit of revolutionaries, knowing even when being tortured that the enemy for all its military might is weak because it goes against the genuine interest of the people. As Mao said all reactionaries and imperialists are paper tigers -- tactically they might seem very strong, like tigers with their sophisticated weapons, but in reality they are weak because they don't rely on people, and are going against the interests of the masses who are the makers of history.

"CHANGES"-NO CHANGE AT ALL!

1980'S -- DECADE OF IMPERIALIST CRISIS.

The 1980's were a decade of crisis for the imperialists, both around the world and in their heartlands. British imperialism was no exception to this and had to squeeze more and more out of the masses pushing the poor deeper into poverty, making the rich richer, sharply polarising society, even cutting into the privileges and comfort of the middle section of society.

The rise in unemployment, the increase in inflation, the introduction of the poll tax and the peoples revolt against it, refusing to pay and taking to the streets of London in March 1990, were the result of a Britain trying to deal with its crisis in the way imperialists always do. -- With more repression and oppression both at home and around the world, with more deadly plans for, and involvement in, the murdering and plundering of other nations, support and military build up of reactionary tyrants, promotion and supplying of regional wars...

RESIGNATIONS, DIVISIONS AND THE LABOUR PARTY IN WAITING.

Faced with growing crisis, speculation about Thatcher's future was ignited at the end of 1989 with the resignation of Nigel Lawson, Chancellor of the Exchequer, over the issues of European Monetary Union and British involvement with its European partners. Of all the problems facing Thatcher's cabinet, Europe and the Poll Tax were the biggest, with the Tories divided over both issues.

For a while it looked as though Labour might be called in to save the day. There was some hint in the media that Neil Kinnock, prime minister in waiting, could make a good Prime Minister, because Labour policies under his leadership did not have any "socialist" elements so there should be no worries. But the Labour Party had to wait longer, despite all their hopes and policy

manoeuvring. British imperialism gave its Prime Minister a breathing period to put the house in order, as the editor of the Sunday Times said "We give her six months to put things right".

LABOUR PARTY STILL IN WAITING.

In November 1990 Geoffrey Howe, the deputy Prime Minister, resigned from the cabinet over the European issue, making it clear that a challenge for leadership of the government should be on the agenda. This raised Labour Party hopes of a move into number ten.

With the crisis facing the system and specifically the government, the prospect of the Conservative Party winning the next election under Thatcher's leadership was remote. In the short term, this is what worried the bourgeoisie. The question they were faced with was either a change in Conservative leadership now or a Labour Party win at the next General Election.

Commentators interviewed various U.S. and European officials around whether they would rather deal with a change of leadership in the Tory Party or with Labour Government.

In the midst of the immediate problems-- around the Gulf, future relations between Britain and Europe, EMU, the question of new developments in the Soviet Union and the rest of East Europe, -- the bourgeoisie chose to change the Conservative leader, saving the Labour Party to bring out of the hat for some other time when its interests could be rescued by the policies of the Labour Party.

OPERATION: SAVE THE TORIES!

Hence, Hestletine, a former Defence Secretary who had to resign over the Westland helicopter affair five years ago, was used to test the ground for getting rid



of Thatcher. When it became clear that Thatcher had not been able to win the first round in the leadership challenge, voices from the media and the Tory Party itself said that Margaret Thatcher had to go.

Hestletine was confident that he would succeed in the second round. Conservative MP, Tim Devlin, said; "The Prime Minister is so badly damaged that a number of people will be switching their support from her to Mr Hestletine in the next ballot." The "gentlemen" in grey suits from the 1922 committee and other representatives of the bourgeoisie started to go to number 10 to have "talks" with Mrs Thatcher, to persuade her that it was better for the "Party", meaning British imperialism, that she resigned.

John Major and Douglas Hurd threw themselves into the second round of the rat race for promoting and safeguarding British interests. The campaign of fear and backstabbing of rats continued for another week as MPs who had previously voted for Hestletine had to consider their position, amidst fears of revenge, if they came out publicly and supported him and worry about their jobs, if he were to lose.

From the beginning the second round of the contest was a show: British imperialism wanted Major as the new Prime Minister. Hurd's role was to divide the votes and ensure Hestletine's failure. This was revealed when a former cabinet minister said about Hurd and Major's campaign that "whatever they say, it is a stop Hestletine campaign." It was clear that Hestletine would not get the job,

When Major came out on top with 185 votes, both "gentlemen" Hurd and Hestletine gave up and asked everyone to "unite" behind the new Prime Minister to save the "unity" of the Party. The show of "we are all united behind the new leader" was played to the media by the very people who were campaigning against him just a few minutes before the results. This "unity" was more a coalition than solid unity. Some MPs called for a cabinet with all three contenders in, and Lord Whitelaw said "I said before the result that I did and would like to see Hestletine in the cabinet."

In the U.S. the news was seen as "great satisfaction here, and a little relief too" (as one Whitehouse official put it), there was no expectation of any change in policy, and Major was portrayed as a "kinder, gentler Thatcherite". In Europe the response was that he was expected "to carry on the legacy of the Thatcher era but to change towards Europe".

1990'S MAJOR'S "ERA OF OPPORTUNITIES"!

The new Prime Minister began talking about the 1990s as "a decade of the most remarkable opportunity" and gave his vision of Britain as a "classless society", promising: "I hope in the next few years to build on these (Thatcher's) achievements. I certainly hope in these years to build a society of opportunity. By that I mean an open society in which what people fulfil will depend on their talent, their application and their good fortune.."

Well, it might seem an impressive speech by a new Prime Minister by bourgeois standards, but it is the same old bullshit the bourgeoisie has been telling us for centuries, that "everyone can make it, and that if they can't then, of course, it is their own fault and nothing to do with the system". This is the same bourgeois logic that has promoted and legitimised all kinds of racism, chauvinism, exploitation and oppression, particularly woman oppression, the plunder and super exploitation of other nations...

The media has wasted no time in marketing and selling Major as the ordinary man from Brixton, very different from other politicians, with no special education, whose achievements, as he himself put it in imperialist logic "depended on his talent and good fortune". -- That was why he made it to the top, and if there are poor white, Black, Irish people, and other oppressed nationalities in the same area living in ghettos, being harassed by the pigs of this supposed "society with many opportunities" and attacked by the fascists who "fulfilled and depended on their talent and good fortune...", it is because they -- the poor white, oppressed nationalities and nothing to lose proletariat -- do not have any "talent", "good fortune", and did not "fulfill and depend on it". And of course the fact that this is an imperialist system based in the capitalist dog eat dog logic of "me first" has nothing whatsoever to do with it!

The reality is, of course oppressed people can not make it in this system. We come into the world with a system already there and have no choice about it, and any time we want to oppose it, the whole system and its force comes down on us. It is this system that determines our relation in society and whether we have "good fortune", "talent" or "fulfillment" or not. It is this system which forces people to relate to each other in certain ways, molds our values and ideas and with the whole economic system and other relations pushes us into "our proper place". We certainly can not make it in this system

but we can overthrow it and bring about a fundamentally different one.

1990'S: REVOLUTION LET'S GO FOR IT!

As for the decade of the 1990s, we have to make sure it is one of nightmares and defeats for the imperialists and of jubilation and victory for the oppressed of the world. We in Britain have a great responsibility and internationalist duty, to bring this about by working for the revolutionary seizure of power in this country under the leadership of the proletariat to help and advance the revolutionary movements around the world, to destroy this imperialist world system and build a new world order breaking every chain!

LABOUR TORY BOTH THE SAME, PLAYING THE DEMOCRACY GAME!

Whilst the Tory leadership contest was on, the Labour Party call for a vote of no confidence against the government and for a General Election were ignored. Neil Kinnock was even reported saying that it would be easier for them to win if Thatcher stayed as Prime Minister.

Media polls which for nearly a year had shown a 15% Labour lead over the Conservatives were shattered and reversed to about 11% behind after the leadership contest. This was such a shock that the future of Labour's leadership came under threat from people both inside and outside of the Party saying they could not see Neil Kinnock as being able to win the next election.

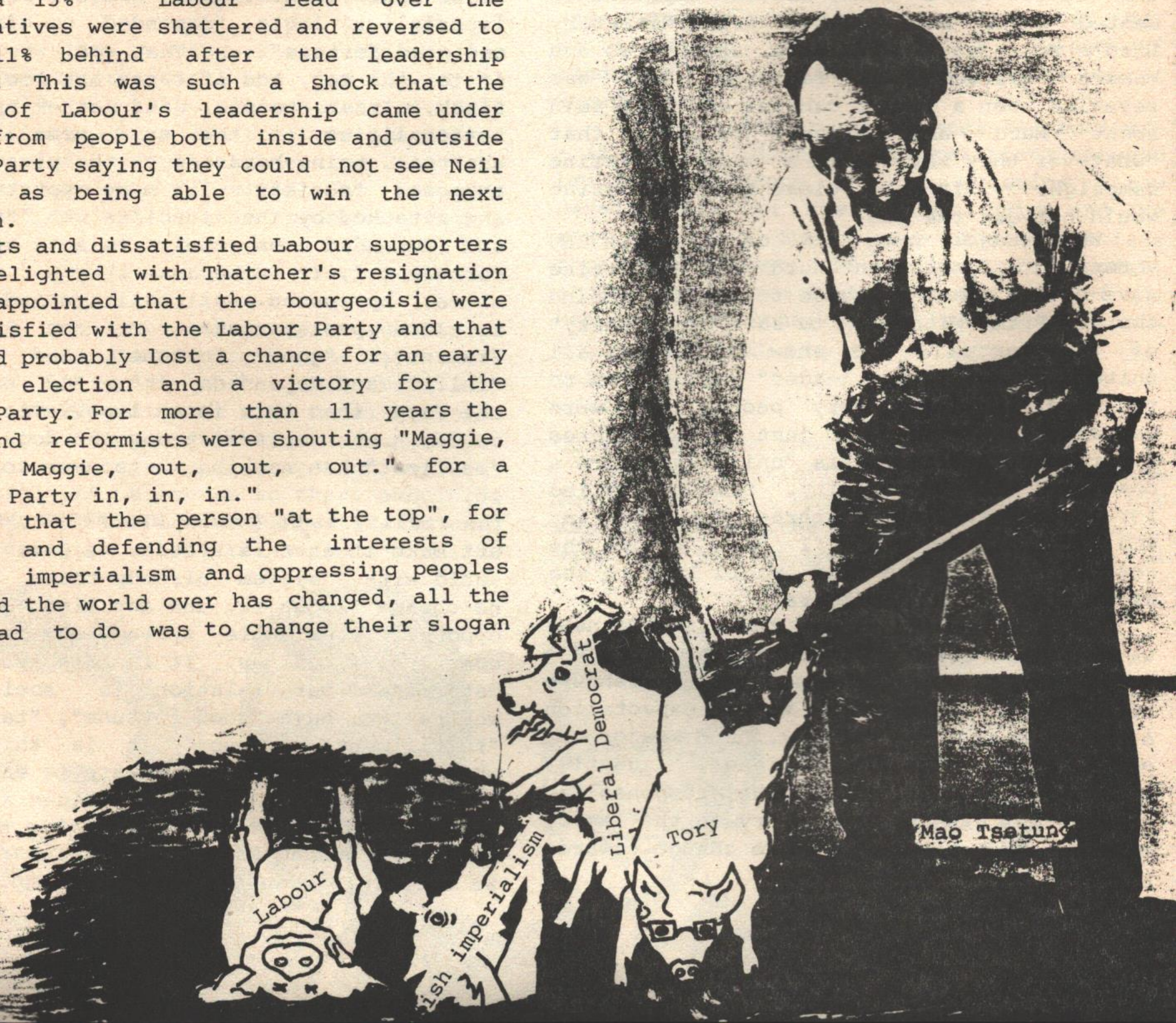
Trots and dissatisfied Labour supporters were delighted with Thatcher's resignation but disappointed that the bourgeoisie were not satisfied with the Labour Party and that they had probably lost a chance for an early general election and a victory for the Labour Party. For more than 11 years the Trots and reformists were shouting "Maggie, Maggie, Maggie, out, out, out." for a "Labour Party in, in, in."

Now that the person "at the top", for running and defending the interests of British imperialism and oppressing peoples here and the world over has changed, all the Trots had to do was to change their slogan

from "Maggie, Maggie, Maggie, out, out, out." to "Major...out". What a farce! For 11 years the Trots and reformists were telling people that if Maggie went everything would be fine, that all we had to do was to help them to get rid of Thatcher and cheer for the Labour Party and Kinnock to come into office to look after the interests of the system and continue our oppression.

But to their disappointment it did not happen this way as the needs of the bourgeoisie in this country, and of its partners in the U.S. and Europe, meant that it was easier to deal with the Tory Party than the Labour Party, considering the world situation, the crisis that British imperialism is in, the fact that Labour policies are not satisfactory yet, and that the Tories can still defend its interests better. The Prime Minister in waiting is still waiting for his turn.

Pigs may come and pigs may go, they may play musical chairs and moving house, but whether by means of general elections, leadership challenges or whatever, this pig system will continue until it is shattered by revolution. And for the oppressed here and the world over, these current "changes" are no change at all.

GUERRILLA FIGHTERS OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF PERU.

There is a growing threat of U.S. intervention in South America, especially in Peru against the revolutionary People's War led by the Maoist Communist Party of Peru (PCP). The U.S. has already got troops in Peru and they are quietly increasing their numbers, whilst people's attention in the U.S. and worldwide is concentrated on the Gulf.

Since the invasion of Panama the bourgeois press has been calling for an intensified U.S. military presence in the Andean countries of Peru, Bolivia and Colombia. The Times says "Bush should not be afraid that he will get involved in another Vietnam in Peru".

The U.S. invasion of Panama has laid the ground for this. U.S. soldiers massacred hundreds of people when they invaded Panama. Mass graves continue to be found. The aim of the invasion was to deepen the U.S.'s military grip on the region and after the invasion the U.S. started pumping Panama with more sophisticated weapons. U.S. imperialism wants to use Panama as a strategic base for more intervention throughout South America, particularly in Peru.

REACTION AGAINST REVOLUTION!

The U.S. already has a Vietnam style base at Santa Lucia in the Upper Huallaga Valley. In April 1990 units of the People's Guerrilla Army surrounded it, attacking it with automatic rifle fire and grenades for hours, damaging seven helicopters. This was the first large scale direct combat between the People's Guerrilla Army and U.S. forces. And it is not likely to be the last! U.S. military personnel are training troops in Peru and the other Andean countries. In April the Bush administration announced the setting up of a green beret base at Junin in the Huallaga Valley, mainly to train Peruvian soldiers to fight the Communist Party of Peru, and a further \$35 million in military aid was given to the Peruvian government. The U.S. has recently appointed a new ambassador to Peru - Anthony Quanton who was the former head of the state department's "anti terrorist" branch and an ambassador to Nicaragua during the creation of the pro-U.S. contra mercenaries. It is probable that they will try to make the same sort of pro U.S. reactionary force in Peru. Throughout the ten years of the People's War the reactionary Peruvian government and

its parasitic U.S. backer have tried desperately to put out the blazes of the People's War by ANY MEANS. Local dogs have wiped out hundreds of villages with helicopter gunships supplied by the USSR and the U.S. The Soviet Union has equipped the Air Force and has sent the same helicopter gunships used against the people of Afghanistan to attack the Peruvian people. In Vietnam the U.S. used the deadly chemical "agent orange" against the people. In Peru these criminals are attacking the people with deadly chemicals and herbicides like "spike" under the guise of killing the coca plant. The Peruvian regime is carrying out genocide. From 1980 these monsters have murdered 17,000 and at least 10,000 have disappeared, out of these, 5,000 are from Ayacucho, the stronghold of the Communist Party of Peru. But all this repression and suppression has inflamed the people's spirit even more to join and support the People's War.

WHAT IS THE REAL FEAR OF U.S. IMPERIALISM?

The victorious advancement of the People's war in Peru has demonstrated that the Peruvian ruling class, despite all its military and financial aid from U.S. imperialism, has been unable to stop the advancement of the People's War. This terrifies the U.S. because they know that if the People's War in Peru is not stopped it will expand in the region and spread to the other countries of South America where conditions are ripe for revolution. As a youth from El Salvador put it: "The People's War in Peru is giving hope and inspiration to people in El Salvador". For the U.S. to intervene militarily in this strategic region, they need a strong base in there. The key aim behind the invasion of Panama was to prepare the ground for more intervention in South America, especially in Peru. All of the imperialist propaganda around "fighting" the drug barons and the drug issue were hypocrisy and lies, as the imperialists and the CIA have always been involved in the drug trafficking business to maintain the deadly grip of imperialism and the local dictators on the dependent countries.

THE PERUVIAN ECONOMY

People's economic situation is getting worse every day. Wages are constantly dropping. In the five years of Alan Garcia's presidency, inflation reached over one million per cent. Over 900,000 are unemployed and four million underemployed.

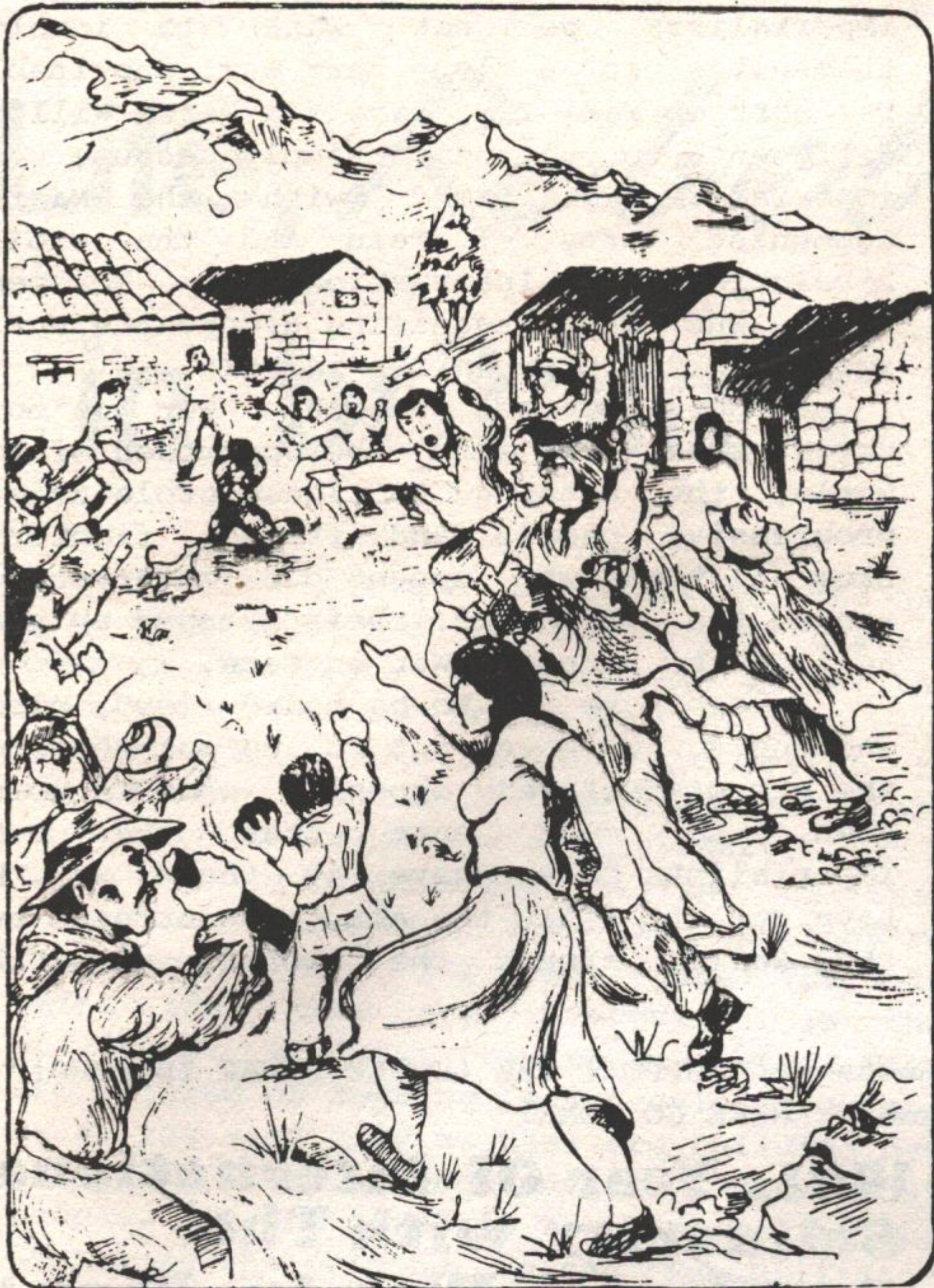
Small and middle-sized industries are going out of business, causing yet more unemployment. 50% of children under six years suffer from chronic malnutrition. Peru has one of the world's highest infant mortality rates.

The new president Alberto Fujimori has followed the same economic programme as his predecessor. With Peru in deep economic and political crisis, the U.S. government has suggested economic and military aid so that the Peruvian government can deal with its internal problems. Fujimori has said his priority is to fight the People's War. In August his new government renewed the state of emergency in the capital, Lima, and extended it to 10 of the country's 24 departments. During the elections, the P.C.P. waged an anti-election campaign, calling upon the people to boycott the election and to join the people's army to step up the People's War for the nationwide seizure of power.



WHAT ARE THE AIMS OF THE PEOPLE'S WAR AND WHAT HAS IT ACHIEVED SO FAR?

17th May 1990 was the tenth glorious year of the People's War in Peru. This revolutionary People's War has spread to 22 of the 24 provinces of Peru. And with every step, it brings happiness and revolutionary hope for the communists and oppressed of the world as the People's Republic of Peru is developing. The People's War has aroused and organised the masses of people from both cities and villages. The P.C.P. will not negotiate with the reactionary Peruvian rulers to share power. To push forward the People's War they are seeking no aid from any imperialist or reactionary power. Instead they are relying on the masses and their own forces. The revolution that is being waged is no half way revolution, its goal is to overthrow the reactionary rulers and the imperialist parasites which have fed themselves on the oppressed, to put an end to imperialist domination and to all oppression, of male dominance over women, of national oppression, of white dominance over non-white...REVOLUTION ALL THE WAY!

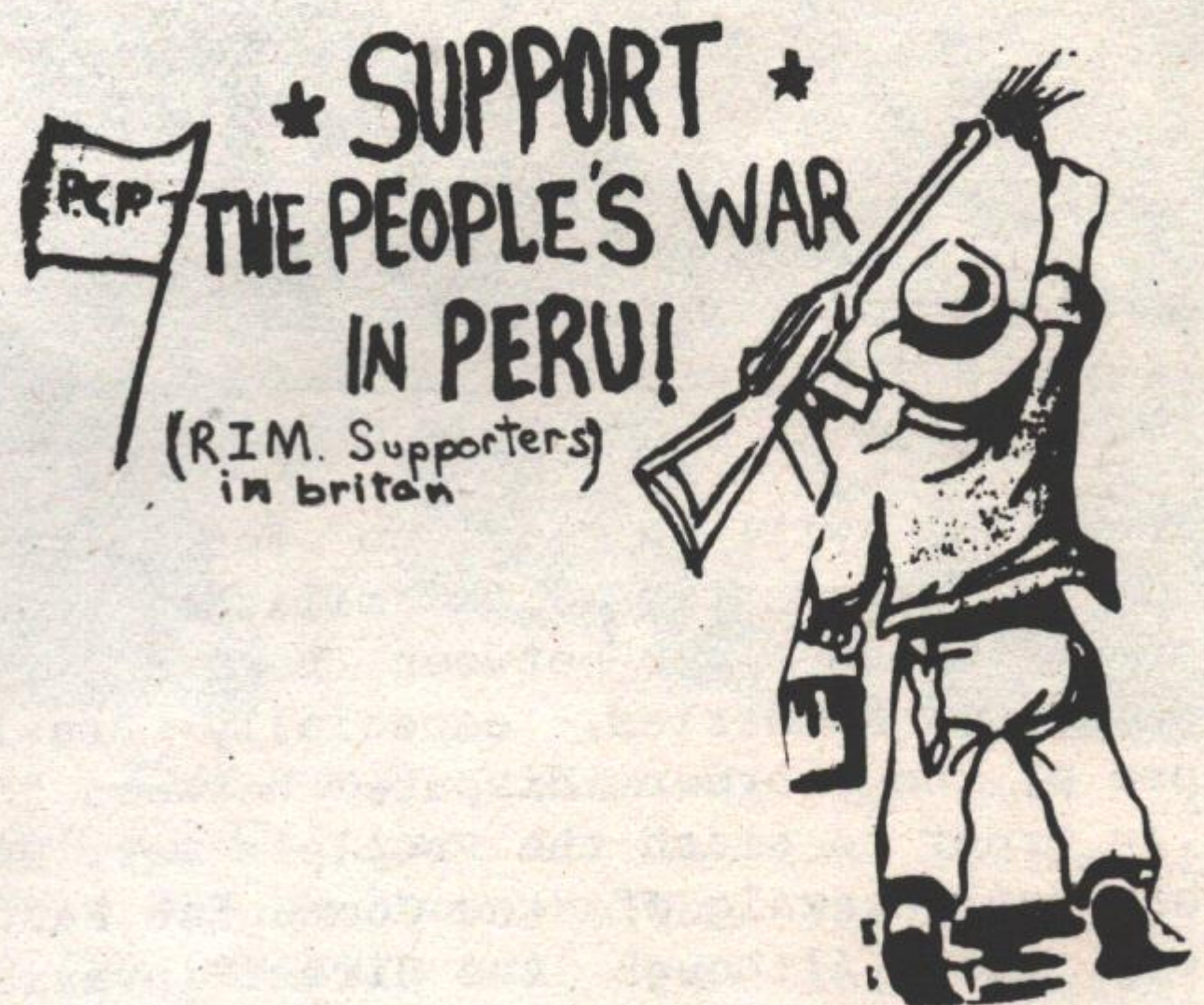


Class struggle has modelled people's mind in countryside!

Even the bourgeois press admits that 1/3 of the country is in the hands of the Communist Party of Peru. In the areas where the reactionary army has not been totally demolished, one of P.C.P.'s policies is to protect the peasants from having their land and crops stolen by landlords, police or drug traffickers. In the areas where the police and army have been defeated and crushed, People's Committees have been formed under the leadership of the Communist Party. Reactionaries have been put on trial in People's Courts. The land of the big landlords and drug traffickers who have been oppressing, raping and sucking the blood of the peasants for centuries is being liberated and divided among the peasants by the People's Committees in the liberated areas. The people of the villages are being organised into cells of the future society within the New Democratic Revolution under the leadership of the party. These People's Committees are to enable the people to get rid of everything that is reactionary, to help them understand the roots of oppression and how to get rid of them by educating and organizing the masses. The women in particular are being encouraged to participate in changing and advancing the world. The struggle against women's oppression is one of P.C.P.'s main tasks among the people. These base areas are as

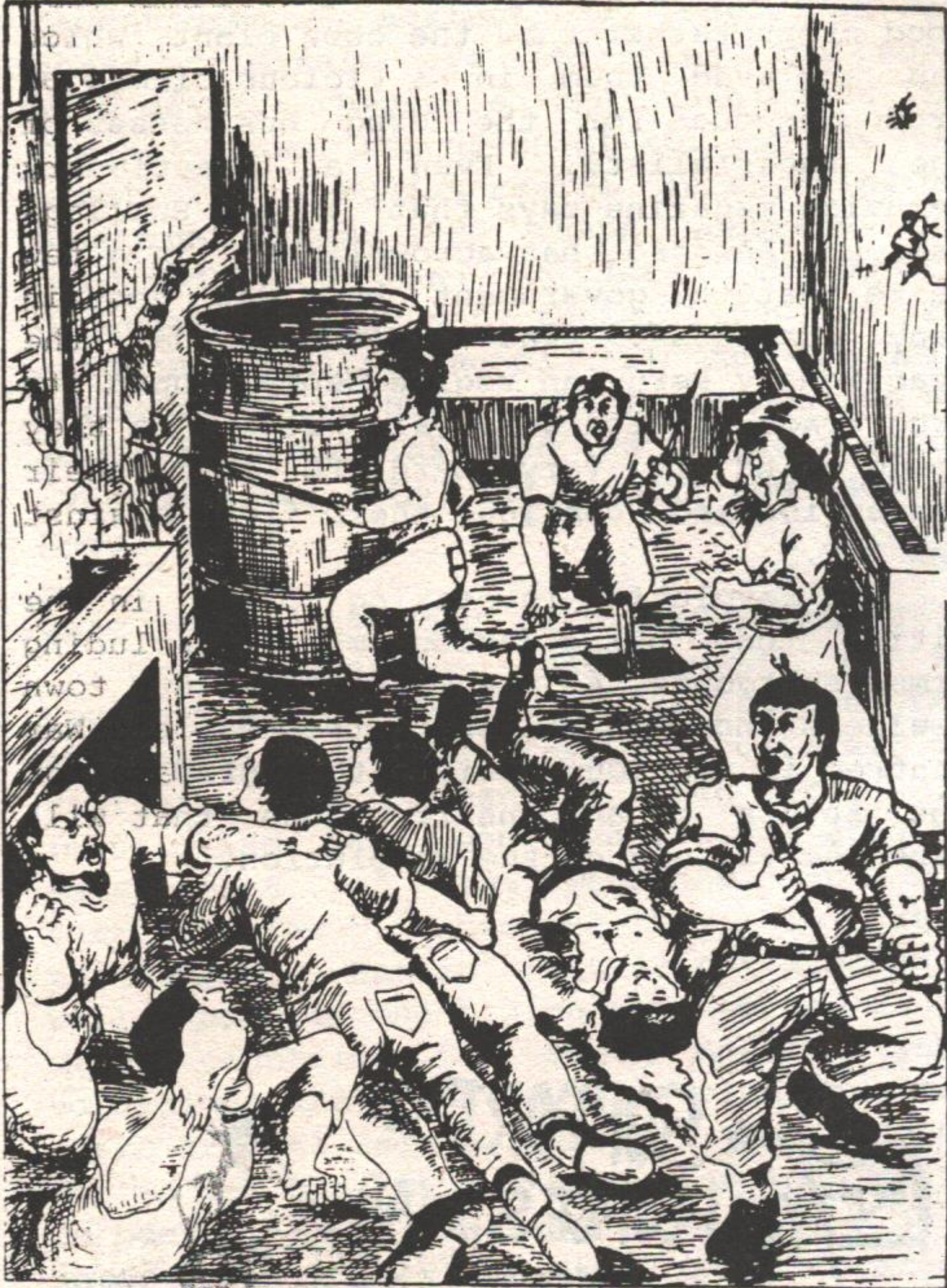
Mao said "the essence of people's war" because through them the masses are unleashed and the war is a truly revolutionary war of the people, not the work of an isolated "roving rebel band". Their aim is to build a free Peru on Maoist principles through self reliance. And that includes elimination of coca production TOTALLY by relying on people's consciousness. P.C.P. are encouraging peasants to plant some of their land with food crops rather than the coca plant, which has enslaved them in a vicious circle of producing coca for the drug businesses of the imperialists. Even a reactionary Peruvian magazine says that in the Hualлага Valley: "Sendero has accomplished in a few years what the government has not done in many decades". The fact is that the reactionary Peruvian regime depends upon its drug trade for its survival. Without it they would find it very hard to fund their repression and continue their fight against the P.C.P.

The revolution is taking place in the cities too, using various means, including armed shutdowns. As the workers, shanty town dwellers and others look to the People's War centred in the countryside, they prepare for the future urban insurrections that will mark the victory of the revolution.



With deepening political, economic and social crisis, more than 60% of Peru's territory has been declared a state of emergency and put under military or police rule. The bourgeois media has kept completely quiet about this. The imperialist media around the globe has managed to virtually stop news of the glorious achievements of the People's War reaching beyond Peru. Mass murders, arrests, mass

disappearances (kidnapping and murder) and torture by government forces have sharply increased. Once again revolutionary prisoners in Peru are facing new threats of genocide from the reactionary government, which will be harsher than June 86 when nearly 400 political prisoners were massacred. Fascist moves by the Peruvian regime and their main backer, the U.S. imperialists, are being stepped up against the people and the People's War.

The U.S. will either go for direct military intervention, a military coup d'etat or impose a war between Peru and its neighbouring countries, especially Brazil because of the border dispute between the two, in order to smash the People's war. But as Chairman Gonzalo of the Communist Party of Peru said: Although the direct invasion by U.S. imperialism will bring forth yet more bloodshed and killings, at the same time it opens a possibility for the Communist Party to widen its influence among the middle class and national bourgeoisie to form and organise a united front on a large scale to oppose U.S. invasion, as the people of South America have deep hatred for the U.S. because of what it has done there. At the same time, having had the experience of protracted war in Vietnam, which cost the U.S. a lot politically and economically, the

imperialists do not want to involve themselves in a long term war. Inevitably the sort of war they face in Peru will be different to Vietnam, simply because U.S. imperialism is faced with the Maoist Communist Party of Peru and the Maoist Revolutionary Internationalist Movement (RIM) who are organising around the world against U.S. intervention in Peru.

Support for the People's War is more urgent than ever from the oppressed of the world, the nothing to loose proletariat, progressive people and freedom fighters, from all those who oppose U.S. intervention around the world and their stepped up plan against the People's War in Peru.

Voices have got to be heard loud, clear and angry, we have got to be out there on the streets actively opposing what is going down, to make sure that the U.S. imperialists do not have it their way. We have got to fill the air, the streets and the walls, around the world, with the

message: "SUPPORT THE PEOPLE'S WAR IN PERU!" and "YANKEE GO HOME!"

Life, Rebellion & Death in Britain's Hell Holes!

As the nature of Britain's prisons has been further exposed by many rebellions and over 42 "suicides" in this year alone, the powers-that-be are trying to get away with murder. They are giving lip-service to reform with various "investigations", talk of improving conditions and trickery.

These criminals are telling us that things are changing. You can bet they're changing -- and for the worse! The only thing that they are improving is the ability of their repressive apparatus. They are talking of sending less people to prison -- at the same time as they are building new prisons! -- and not because they care about people, but because of the expense and the fact that the prisons do not "rehabilitate" the prisoners. It costs £15,000 per year to keep someone in prison compared to 1,000 under probation supervision and according to their Criminal Justice Bill: "It can be an expensive way of making bad people worse". What they mean is that we go in anti-system and we come out even more anti-system! As for these community based punishments the powers-that-be are pushing for, they aren't doing us any favours either! Electronic tagging and curfews are being introduced to terrorize and control people in the community as a lesson to others. And these hypocrites are using the "suicides" in jail to consider introducing spy cameras into cells! - To further degrade and control prisoners. As for Strangeways, forget about the vermin (rats and screws), the beatings and the drugging, the systems verdict was that the prisoners needed more of the same and worse. "What was needed was an emphasis on control and restraint techniques." And that is what all these so called "reforms" are all about.

WHAT IS "CRIME" AND WHO'S INSIDE?

Thatcher oinked that "Crime is not a sickness to be cured. It's a temptation to be resisted, a threat to be deterred and an evil to be punished". But the system is criminalising, framing up and imprisoning us! And they call us the "criminals". This system makes it a "crime" to be poor, a "crime" to be from the oppressed nationalities, a "crime" to be angry, rebellious, to live!

Also many of us are inside for petty "offenses" - but just where does this "crime" they're always squeaking about come from? It is this capitalist system that creates the poverty, the desperation that can drive people into "crime" to survive, and even the government's own "crime" figures can not hide the link with poverty. Someone reaching for a loaf of bread with empty pockets gets a heavy sentence. Whilst the Guinness type crooks... usually get away with it or gets a tiny fine or token sentence, just to tell us that this system "punishes" its gangsters.



They say "crime is an evil to be punished", but it is this system that is evil and we know who the real criminals are - the suckers who run this system, who commit mass murder and plunder around the globe. We can see some of them on the tv, live from Westminster. Where we don't see them is standing in the dock or doing time in the slammer.

"Crime" is a product of this system and its ideology. This system injures our minds, trying to turn us against each other instead of directing our anger at the system. "Crime" is exactly a sickness to be cured and it can only be eliminated through the revolutionary struggle to overthrow and abolish capitalism.

WHAT ARE PRISONS FOR?

They sometimes claim that prisons are "rehabilitation centres". More often, they call them places where "animals" are put to stop them "harming law abiding citizens". More pig lies. Prisons are instruments of bourgeois dictatorship, there to contain, control and to terrorise, to break the spirit of those who rebel and to tell people to chill out or this is what you'll get - isolation, torture, needles forced into veins to zombify us with drugs, and murder.

LIFE AND DEATH IN BRITAINS HELL HOLES.

Germain Alexander died in Brixton Prison. The Home Office told us that he died from "breathing difficulties", the inquest claimed that he died from "natural causes aggravated by lack of care". What really happened was that he was savagely beaten and murdered in the cells of Brixton prison by 6 pigs in full riot gear armed with truncheons - which these terrorists call "about as useful as a chocolate fireguard" and are calling for an even more lethal weapon.

This pig system "condemns" regimes that imprison children and talks about "human rights", whilst it locks away more people than Turkey, and imprisons children and youth, in secure units, in "lock down" in children's homes and in adult prisons. And now it says they're going to tag "offenders" who are 16 and over - like we're animals!

The fact is that this wicked system eats the young. It's scared of the anti-system youth and wants to crush their rebelliousness knowing the major role they play in rebellions and in revolutionary struggle. When 15 year old Philip Knight was found hanged in a prison cell the system cried crocodile tears, Waddington (Home Office minister) claimed distress. The Chief Inspector of Prisons, Tumin's report into "suicides at Armley prison says they are caused by the overcrowding and bad conditions but the fact is that they can end these things, but the oppressive nature of britains hell holes remains the same. As a former inmate of Armley described: "... a lad who was sharing a cell with me went and told the officers he was feeling a bit down. He said he might end up doing something stupid. They sent him back and told me: 'Keep an eye on him and, if he doesn't succeed, hang him yourself.' That was sick. they weren't bothered. He was only 17...Almost every night you would hear banging on the door when lads were trying to tell officers that their cellmate was attempting suicide. No one ever got to know. They kept it quiet."

Some people might say: what about these inquests, inquiries and investigations that they have every so often? Well what about them? They're trying to tell us that the system is reformable not overthrowable, that these deaths in the prisons and the pig cells, you know the ones, are from "lack of care", "suicide" and "natural causes". But the cold truth is that the system is responsible for all these deaths and all are murders whether the inmates were beaten and killed by the screws or pushed and driven to kill themselves. They're talking about bringing back hanging. But who says that these murderers have done away with hanging? Who says that there is no death sentence in Britain? How many young lives have been cut off in their prime dangling from prison sheets? How many people have been murdered in the prisons and pig cells?

STRANGWAYS RIGHTEOUS, RIGHTEOUS REBELLION!

The Strangeways rebellion following on Trafalgar really shook up and humiliated the powers-that-be. They'd locked these rebels away and done all they could to beat them down, broken their bones, drugged them with the "liquid cosh" and yet here they were storming the prison, up on the roof and taking over the prison for 26 smashing days, exposing the true nature of the prison system, with a paper loud speaker and written slogans, to the people massing happily below. Making fun of the powers-



that-be, dancing on the roof, hurling slates down on the pigs squeaking below, smashing up the prison and setting it ablaze, spreading revolt to over 40 other prisons and showing the world the true nature of british "democracy" and the "civilised" nature of imperialism when they proclaimed: "We can stand no more of these bad conditions. We are up here for human rights. Stop the brutality and all punishments. We're sick of the beatings. We are having no more." and "They've told us we're going out in body bags." They fought with the riot police and the screws below, who tried desperately and unsuccessfully to break their spirit with constant physical and mental torture, sirens screeching, water cannon and poison. The rebels went down in the same spirit as they went up -- with clenched fists hitting the air in defiance.

The prisoners showed again what people can do armed with nothing but their anger, initiative and determination. As the prison governor was forced to admit: "When you have hundreds of people determined to fight, there are limited things you can do about it".

The bourgeoisie did not storm the prison because being on the roof the rebels were in embarrassingly public view. And with pictures of people taking on the police in Trafalgar being flashed across the screens of the East, the illusion of western and british "democracy", that they had created, especially in Eastern Europe, was at stake. Also they knew that if they did storm the prison, things could get out of their hands. and the fires of revolt blaze out of control throughout the entire prison network.

Once the cameras had gone the system came down hard on the rebels. One of whom escaped from the pig sty! They are bringing in the Criminal justice bill with 10 years for "prison mutiny", threatening: "Every prisoner on arriving in prison will be warned that that's what he stands to get if he causes trouble".

Ian McKinlay, 19 years old and one of the last down from the roof died on June 25, murdered by the pig system that for months covered up this so called "suicide" which occurred when he was on hunger strike in isolation, locked up 23 hours a day, sexually abused and beaten by the screws. Len Jackson, Hindley's POA grunted "To say that an officer did that is absolutely ridiculous. It's more than his job is worth..." Correction. It is exactly what his job is based on.

This pig system murdered Ian McKinlay and wants to use his death to intimidate, but we know the truth of James Connolly's words that "If you strike at, imprison, or kill us, out of our prisons or graves we will still evoke the spirit that will thwart you and rise the force that will destroy you". They're trying to use these deaths to show us that we can't do anything. But what these murders show us is that nothing makes sense except rising up to smash this bloodthirsty system.

APARTHEID ~~BLACK ON BLACK VIOLENCE!~~



May 1990—South African police attack squatters in crossroads.

Since mid August a bloody war has been going on between different sections of Black people, in the townships and squatter camps of Johannesburg, in Azania. Nearly 1,000 people have been killed. These attacks have been carried out by migrant workers from the Zulu tribes who live in hostels, against people in the townships and squatter camps, mainly from the Xhosa tribes. These migrant workers are significantly influenced by the Zulu Chief Buthelezi and his reactionary Inkatha movement, who in the words of a revolutionary activist "really run the hostel for the police and Pretoria". Apartheid has used this situation to suppress and brutalize Black people even more by imposing a curfew on townships around Johannesburg. Police set up road blocks on routes leading out of the townships, searching every car, and residents face up to six months imprisonment if found on the streets between 9pm and 4am, reserve police and army units are being called in, and in a new policy, machine guns are being mounted on top of the police vehicles. All this means more vicious attacks on Black people by apartheid.

The reactionary media is telling us that this bloody war is all about rivalry between Black tribes and is desperately trying to show that the South African government has nothing to do with it, except in as much as it is trying to create a "better atmosphere" - as de Klerk says - for resolving this conflict!

BUT THE REALITY IS THAT APARTHEID IS THE CAUSE OF THIS BLOODSHED. As an official of a local residents' association (Guardian 24 August) said: "This is not a tribal war. I am a Zulu but my friends here all speak Xhosa. It is the (state) system which is orchestrating this conflict to destabilize progressive forces."

Over the years conflicts between sections of Black people has been fueled and intensified by the apartheid system. This policy of divide and rule is the dirty trick of the ruling classes throughout history, using religion, nations, tribes, etc. This Chief Buthelezi and his Inkatha movement have been an attack dog for apartheid for years. For years Inkatha followers have killed, beaten up and burnt Black people in the townships and squatter camps, particularly members of the Anti

Apartheid organizations.

At the start of negotiations between the ANC and de Klerk, Nelson Mandela asked the rebel youth to throw their weapons into the sea. This caused great dissatisfaction among the radical masses and the rebel youth who refuse to compromise with this white settler colonialist system of apartheid, that has been created by the imperialists, and which has murdered and brutalised their people from day one. The apartheid system wanted to punish these uncompromising rebel youth and radicals by setting the reactionary Inkatha dog on them, hoping to destroy their fighting spirit and bring them to a level where they would settle for the dealings that the ANC brings forward through its negotiations with de Klerk.

IT IS RIGHT TO REBEL!

The rebel youth did not throw their weapons into the sea. They are resisting and fighting back against the apartheid security forces and Inkatha's vicious attacks.

The bourgeois media is trying to blame the youth for the bloodshed, saying (Observer 30 September) that "street thugs who terrorized the townships under the guise of the black liberation struggle... are one reason for the wave of black on black violence". The system has always attempted to put down any righteous rebellion under the name of "street gangs, street thugs..." Just like the british media tried to do with the righteous Poll Tax rebellions. The bourgeois media intentionally mix the rebel youth with mercenaries who have been hired by hidden hands -

the apartheid system - attempting to show to the people of the world that this fighting, this "black on black violence" that the reactionary media propagates, is inevitable without the "greater control" of apartheid, thereby justifying apartheid's creation and its continued existence.

U.S. AND BRITISH IMPERIALISM IN PRAISE OF THEIR "REFORMED" CREATION.

When Nelson Mandela and Walter D... was released from prison by de Klerk, Thatcher and Bush started praising de Klerk and Bush even considered calling off the so called sanctions "against" apartheid.

Recently F W de Klerk went to visit his masters in the U.S. They met in the white house pig sty and Bush said "the South African program to dismantle apartheid is courageous and irreversible". And what a "surprise"!: All of a sudden during de Klerk's trip Inkatha's vicious attacks

stopped altogether and only started again when de Klerk was back in Azania! Why? Because de Klerk along with the U.S. imperialists wanted to create public opinion around the world that "reformer" de Klerk is paving the way to "dismantle" apartheid, and to pull the curtain over the sinister operation of apartheid's security forces in the recent fighting.

Imperialism and apartheid are the cause of the current situation, and the responsibility for all the killings must be laid at their door. Residents of the townships say Zulus belonging to the Inkatha movement are being used by apartheid security forces to provoke a township war with Xhosa speaking tribes. Residents of Kagiso township saw Zulus being driven into the area by whites who were clearly from the security forces. Some victims of these Inkatha attacks have seen white police taking part, wearing black masks. One example of many joint operations between whites and Inkatha is the attack on Thokoza squatter camp, a township south east of Johannesburg. On the night of September 12,400 shacks were burnt down and at least 6 local people were killed. Locals saw the bodies of at least 3 whites. Whilst the invasion was going on pigs in armoured cars repeatedly gave support to the attackers and then came in the morning and took away the white bodies. The only people who would go armed at midnight are with the authorities.

There are also reports of an ANC video showing Inkatha warriors being taken in police armoured personnel carriers to the Transvaal township of Zonk'iziwe where recent bloody clashes happened.

But today in Azania it is not only Inkatha and the security forces who terrorize and kill residents from the townships. There are also attacks carried out by hired mercenaries, organised by the same "hidden hands" responsible for the other attacks - the apartheid system itself. One example of which is the raid on a train carrying Black workers from Johannesburg to Soweto, at least 26 were killed and over 100 injured. The fascist white settler state of South Africa has throughout its existence used the reactionary policy of divide and rule and has managed to build up a wide variety of collaborators, mercenaries, informers and death squads aimed at Black activists. With the recent attacks, apartheid ignites, fuels and participates in attacks against Black people unofficially, whilst at the same time officially using the

occasion to escalate repression against the Black masses. Today the very same murderous white settler state puts Winnie Mandela on trial charging that she was involved in capturing some youths and killing one of them 2 years ago. This has got nothing to do with justice and everything to do with putting pressure on the ANC, in order to make its bargaining position weaker. The apartheid system are hitting at, and attempting to discredit her, because from the ANC she has been closest to the youth. We Maoists believe that this blood soaked apartheid system has no right to put Winnie Mandela or anyone else on trial. This vicious white ruling class and its atrocities against the oppressed masses of Azania has been supported and praised by the U.S. and british imperialists and the rest.



IMPERIALISM AND APARTHEID ARE THE MURDERERS.

The apartheid system is there to serve imperialists interests. These imperialists are soaked in the blood of Black people and are responsible for the current bloodbath as well. Whilst they are talking so much about it, hypocritically claiming to be "worried" about it, the fact is that it serves their interests and is caused by their policies there. These bloodthirsty imperialists want apartheid to stay and want the "Black on Black" violence and every kind of violence and oppression against Black people to continue, because it is exactly these policies that are guaranteeing their grip on the region. They want people to forget about the real issue of imperialism and apartheid, to bring everything down to Black people "killing each other", and putting out the vicious lie that they should be grateful that the apartheid system is there to keep them apart and to send in its security forces. All of these killings are serving the imperialists by prolonging apartheid.

What the imperialists do not want is for people to unite and wage armed struggle to get rid of the apartheid system once and for all.

WHERE DOES THE ANC STAND IN THE RECENT FIGHTING?

In an interview on "Panorama" Mandela said "I have asked many times from the South African government to send in the security forces to protect people of the townships, but they have not done anything... There are some elements in the security forces who are igniting the conflict to reduce the influence of the ANC over youths. And since the security people did not protect our people so, we have to bring in our military wing to protect the people". Asking security forces to step in and "protect" people is just like asking the british army to step in to "protect" the Irish masses against Loyalist violence. And the ANC's outlook does not go further to expose the whole nature of the white settler state, it only goes so far as to say "some elements in security forces". This is because the ANC does not want to spoil the negotiation process. Although Mandela declared not long ago that the ANC will stop the armed struggle, the recent situation has given rise to a righteous feeling among the masses, especially among the youth, of wanting to fight back with arms, to take the struggle to a higher level.

So Mandela talks about the Military Wing to alarm the apartheid system. He is warning apartheid that because the masses are demanding armed struggle, they have to get on with the negotiations as quickly as possible, otherwise the people will either push the ANC into armed struggle or start it themselves. But even when the ANC upheld armed struggle, it never had the aim of overthrowing the whole apartheid system. The ANC has always used the armed struggle to pressure apartheid and bring it to the negotiation table. The recent violence is not an attempt to cut short the influence of the ANC as Mandela thinks. Actually it is a crackdown waged by the fascist apartheid system to destroy the fighting spirit of the masses against apartheid, especially the youth, in order to make them settle for any dealings that the apartheid system puts forward for the oppressed people. Now, even the ANC is using this situation to secure its grip over the youth and influence them by having its military wing play a role in these incidents. While at the same time by having the military wing on standby gives a message to apartheid that negotiations are getting spoiled and they are not doing anything to

stop it. De Klerk is pressurizing Mandela to hold talks with the reactionary Buthelezi, collaborator with apartheid, so that he would be considered as a third party in power sharing. The ANC does not want to do that, because it will make bargaining harder for the ANC, although under pressure Mandela said that he will talk to Buthelezi. The events surrounding the recent meeting that didn't happen between Buthelezi and Mandella exposed even more the reactionary nature of Buthelezi and Incatha who were escorted on the trip by the security forces. It also showed to what depth's Mandela is prepared to sink in wanting unity with this Inkatha dog and a negotiation and power sharing with the apartheid white supremacy system. The masses are calling for an end to negotiations with apartheid. They have experienced the apartheid system and all its massacres and violence over the years. They know that Inkatha is its hidden hands. During the recent slaughter the involvement

of the system and its security forces has become even more obvious. It is possible therefore that the ANC may have to stop the negotiation process because of the pressure put on them by the people of the townships, particularly by the youth who refused to listen when Nelson Mandela told them to throw their weapons into the sea.

A wide section of the oppressed people in Azania are of the belief that the ANC will lead them to liberation. But the reality is that the white settler colonialist state exists and feeds itself upon the oppression and brutalization of the oppressed people of Azania. And as long as this murderous system lives, the oppression will continue. The only way out is all the way revolution, under the leadership of a proletarian party to unite and unleash the conscious fury of the masses, to wipe out apartheid through the violent seizure of power. The path of revolution in Azania is People's War based on the science of Marxism-Leninism-Maoism.

THE COURTS -- IS IT A MISCARRIAGE OF BRITISH "JUSTICE"?



too clearly the real face of the british legal system. The releases and reviews are an attempt to keep people's illusions about british "justice" (particularly among their social base, the middle classes). They are trying to turn reality on its head by painting the Guildford Four releases as a triumph for british "justice"! They are putting out the lie that there may have been a miscarriage of "justice" in one or two exceptional cases, but that basically the system is sound! They want us to believe what a good system it is, innocent people are being released! british imperialism together with its reactionary press tried desperately to propogate this with headings like: "A strange miscarriage of English justice". But, of course, as the oppressed know only too well, there is nothing strange at all in this.

The ruling class has always been prepared to sacrifice a scapegoat here and there to save itself. This time it attempted to do so at the expense of the police who handled these cases. This certainly does not mean that the ruling class has lost faith in its police force, or that suddenly they've decided to make everything fair and clean, quite to the contrary, they exactly know the police's brutal and murderous nature and how it operates. Because they have created and fed it as one of the repressive apparatus of their bourgeois dictatorship.

The fact that the british state was forced to release Carole Richardson, Gerald Conlon, Patrick Armstrong and Paul Hill (the Guildford Four) is truly a victory for the people. It also shows that the ruling class is trying to save its "justice" system. It had become obvious to the majority of people that, the Guildford Four and others had been framed. Even judges such as Denning were not happy with these cases because they showed

ARE SOME BLACK FACES IN THE POLICE FORCE GOING TO MAKE IT FREE OF RACISM?

The pig system wanted to tell us that it was just a few rotten apples and not the whole force, or whole system that must go. After many exposures of police fabrication, brutality and outright murder, with opinion polls showing a loss of support for the police even among the middle class, the system has had to attempt to create a new image for the police: Adverts have appeared on the tube aiming to "reduce public prejudice towards the police", especially from the "ethnic minorities". Police posters state "racist attacks are against the law". What a sickening lie! It is the pig enforcers of the law who promote and carry out a high percentage of the racist attacks in the first place. Take the racist raids on housing estates like Broadwater Farm and Lewisham under the name of the so called "war on drugs". Every year many Black youth are murdered whilst in the custody of the police. In 1989 alone, 9 Black men were killed in Brixton police station. You're walking down the road, you're driving your car, you're in your own place and suddenly it's back against the wall and you're under arrest! Take Jamie Stewart, picked up and murdered by the pigs because he was Black. Police harassment, arrests, beatings and murders, they're happening every day to the millions of oppressed, and particularly to the oppressed nationalities. And the police say they're not racist! This 999 is a joke! They never move their ass if we are under attack from the fascists. They do nothing. Or they come and arrest us. Or they come with the bodybags. Yet when we fight back, they can't get there quick enough. And when we demonstrate against the racist attacks, the pigs and the state's secret army of fascists join in attacking us. And they tell us that they're put there to "protect us"!

Recruitment posters and the "Black in Blue" tv series are being used in an attempt to improve the image of the police, and try desperately to recruit Black people to join the repressive police force. The bourgeoisie wants to get Black people into the police force to hide its vicious racist nature and its attacks upon Black people, and to propagate that the only interest of the police is to "protect" people from "crime"! - But all these pitiful attempts by the pig system are doomed to failure because the day to day reality and struggle of people, especially from the oppressed nationalities, directly reveals the real nature of these vicious murderous pigs. These campaigns also show the weakness of the pigs, as BDP raps

in "Who protects us from you?": "There was a time when a Black man couldn't be down with your crew, now you want all the help you can get, scared, well ain't that true..."

Current legal cases by a ex soldier and police officer exposing the racist attacks they experienced have embarrassed the police, exposing their recent campaigns even more.

The police are our enemies and most people from the oppressed nationalities know this. However, a few have illusions about its nature. In 1989 the metropolitan police recruited 1,791 Black officers. 1,533 of these have already left. They experience the same racism and brutality that they have experienced outside in society day and night, they see the pigs attacking their brothers and sisters under the excuse of "war on drugs", they are being verbally and physically abused in racial attacks by other police officers. And some of them realise that the police force is an oppressive tool of this system. As one former officer said: "Most of us leave in droves when we realise what it's like. And those who stay tend to be Uncle Toms".

We know that having Black people in the force does not determine its nature, that it is the whole bourgeois dictatorship, the white supremacy, the woman oppression, the exploitation and oppression on which this pig system is based that makes a pig a pig. The living example of the changes Britain is trying to introduce here, is to be found in the U.S., where over the years the system has recruited thousands of Black people into the police force, to chief of police and mayor. But, of course, it did nothing to change the nature of the system and Black, Latin American, and native Indians face more racism and repression.

The recent use of undercover Black officers in a "war on drugs" operation, leading up to a police raid upon the Matta Fancatta Movement (MFM) Youth and Community Centre shows why the police are so keen to recruit Black people -- they want to use them in order to step up the systems attacks on the Black community. As the MFM chairman said: "They simply want to use Black people to police the Black Community."

A PIG IS A PIG IS A PIG!

They can talk about the "police service" instead of the "police force", they can talk about a "new policing style..." and a "renegotiation of the contract between the police and the community". They can claim as in this recent, much propagated, "code of

conduct" that "officers will have to be compassionate, courteous, patient, unprejudiced, professional, calm and restrained...."(!) But as we know, pigs are pigs - agents of the state working to fully protect this imperialist system and all the repressive and oppressive things that it stands for, and to put us inside for being nothing to loose, proletariat. And we know when they start talking about "community policing" and improving their relationship with the oppressed that it means intensified repression on the streets. Their recent talk about freeing up the bureaucracy to put more police on the beat has absolutely nothing to do with our safety, just the opposite, it means more invasion of our communities, more stop and searches, more youth murdered. They are trying to organise themselves more efficiently, to oppress us more. This is their answer to people's struggles and it shows their desperation and can only lead to more resistance.



CAST AWAY ILLUSIONS!

Right now the powers are in deep economic and political crisis. They are trying to offload it on to us and prevent us from going up in their face, to confuse people and create illusions. They talk "reform" and come down with intensified repression. What they mean by "reform" is how to run the system, and do worse than they are doing to us now, in a more efficient and less costly way avoiding the threat and embarrassment of rebellions. With recent events, the ruling class is turning the whole issue of british "justice" upside down, talking about "wrongful imprisonment" in order to show how good british imperialism is because it has freed innocent people! But the fact is that there is no such thing as "rightful imprisonment" under this capitalist system. Injustice is what imperialism's "justice" is all about and in this capitalist system there can be no justice.

As Peter Tosh says "Everybody's talking about crime, crime, crime, but tell me who are the criminals.." This pig system that enslaves, degrades, and oppresses people the world over, which creates mass slaughter in the reactionary wars and uses people as long as they can make money off of them, uses them up and then throws them on the garbage heap, this murderous system and those who run and enforce it are the real criminals. And the campaign about british "justice" is nothing but preparation for more repression and suppression.

Some people might still say that the system can reform, that we should give it more time, or see what happens with a Labour government. But it will be more of the same. Labour has always said that it will increase policing to "end crime".

After the Poll Tax rebellion the Labour Party condemned the attack on "democracy" and "freedom" and said "The Tories should be uniting with Labour to stamp out this kind of violence." What more does the Labour Party have to do or say to show where they really stand, to break people's illusions about them, and to show they will defend the system at any cost.

When the Labour Party was in power, the same arrests and frameups went on. And they will continue, until this system is wiped out, WHICHEVER political party has power. Some people might still say that we should not rise up and smash the system - So we must give this system some time to improve itself and change its nature? Well, alright, how long, a month, a year,....one hundred years...two hundred years? Okay. Time is up! All the way revolution is the only solution.
