NEW TIENTSIN REVOLUTIONARY COMMITTEE HAILED (7 Jecember 1967)

> [Full text of a Jen-min Jih-pao and Chieh-fang-chun Pao editorial entitled "Both Banks of the Hai River Glow in the Morning Sun."]

With the utmost solicitude of Chairman Mao and under the brilliant illumination of his latest wise instructions, the Tientsin municipal revolutionary committee, following the example of its counterparts in Shanghai and Peking, has been born in one of our great cities.

"The beach of Pona blazed totally red, and both banks of the Hai River glow in the morning sun." The founding of Tsientsin municipal revolutionary committee has rudely ended the fond dream of China's Khrushchev and his agents in Tientsin of capitalist restoration and has declared the complete pankruptcy of their counterrevolutionary revisionist criminal rule. We warmly acclaim this new victory for Chairman Mao's proletarian revolutionary line! We warmly greet this new victory of the infinitely brilliant Mao Tse-tung's thought!
