[Honan revolutionary committee's Notice No 1]

[Text] The Honan provincial revolutionary committee was proclaimed as established on 27 January 1968, with the approval of Chairman Mao and the Party Central Committee. It issues the following notice:

1--The Honan provincial revolutionary committee consists of 155 members. Comrade Liu Chien-hsun is chairman. Comrades Wang Hsin, Chi Teng-kuei, (Keng Chi-kang) and Yang Li-yung and, temporarily, one or two representatives of revolutionary mass organizations are vice chairmen.

2--With immediate effect, all the party, political financial, and cultural powers of the former Honan Provincial CCP Committee and People' Council belong to the provincial revolutionary committee.

3--The most fundamental tasks of the provincial revolutionary committee, the revolutionary committees and preparatory groups at all levels, and revolutionary mass organizations are to raise still higher the great red banner of Mao Tse-tung's thought, fully implement Chairman Mao's latest instructions, run Mao Tse-tung thought study courses in a big way, and launch extensively a mass campaign to study and apply Chairman Mao's works creatively.

H--The Honan provincial revolutionary committee, revolutionary committees and preparatory groups at all levels, and revolutionary mass organizations must follow closely the great leader Chairman Mao's great strategic plan, resolutely struggle against words or actions from the right or the ultraleft which interfere with the main orientation of the struggle, and resolutely strike down bourgeois and pettybourgeois factionalism. They must unfold revolutionary great repudiation to great depth, consolidate and develop revolutionary great alliance and revolutionary threeway alliance, and organize well the struggle-criticism-reform in their units. All factories, schools, departments, and enterprises must, in accordance with the center's instructions, form revolutionary great alliance by systems, trades, and classes. All organizations which cover more than one trade should be readjusted as required, on the principle of voluntariness.

5--It is essential to unite the great majority of the masses and cadres, resolutely implement Chairman Mao's cadre policy, and deal correctly with the cadres. Exception for traitors, special agents, and diehard party capitalist-roaders, all the cadres must be united and educated. More revolutionary cadres must be helped to stand out to and make revolution. Resolutely oppose the method of dealing with cadres by means of bourgeois and petty-bourgeois factionalism.

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6--Resolutely respond to Chairman Mao's great call, launch a "support the army and cherish the people" campaign on a still greater scale, trust and rely on the PLA more, uphold and cherish the PLA, and learn from and help the PLA. Take strict precautions against class enemies sowing discord between army and people. Strengthen further the unity of army and people.

7--Strengthen the dictatorship of the proletariat and defend the new revolutionary order. Strictly supervise landlords, rich peasants, counterrevolutionaries, bad " elements, and rightists. They are only allowed to obey the rules, they are not allowed to act and speak in an unruly fashion. Resolutely suppress active counterrevolutionaries who sabotage the great proletarian cultural revolution and socialist production and construction. Severely punish the plotters who provoke struggle by force, and the archeriminals. Deal resolute blows at the criminal activities of good-for-nothings, thieves, and others which harm the social order. Resolutely implement the center's "6 June" and "5 September" orders. Beating, smashing, looting, and (?illegal) arrest are strictly forbidden.

S--Resolutely implement Chairman Mao's great principle of grasping revolution and boosting production. It is essential to persist in making revolution on the spot, in one's sparetime, and economically. Labor discipline must be strictly observed. A Absence from work without reason is not allowed. Make a success of coal production, insure normal railway transport, and fulfill and overfulfill state quotas. Cherish state property and oppose extravagance and waste. Go all out to win victory in both revolution and production.
